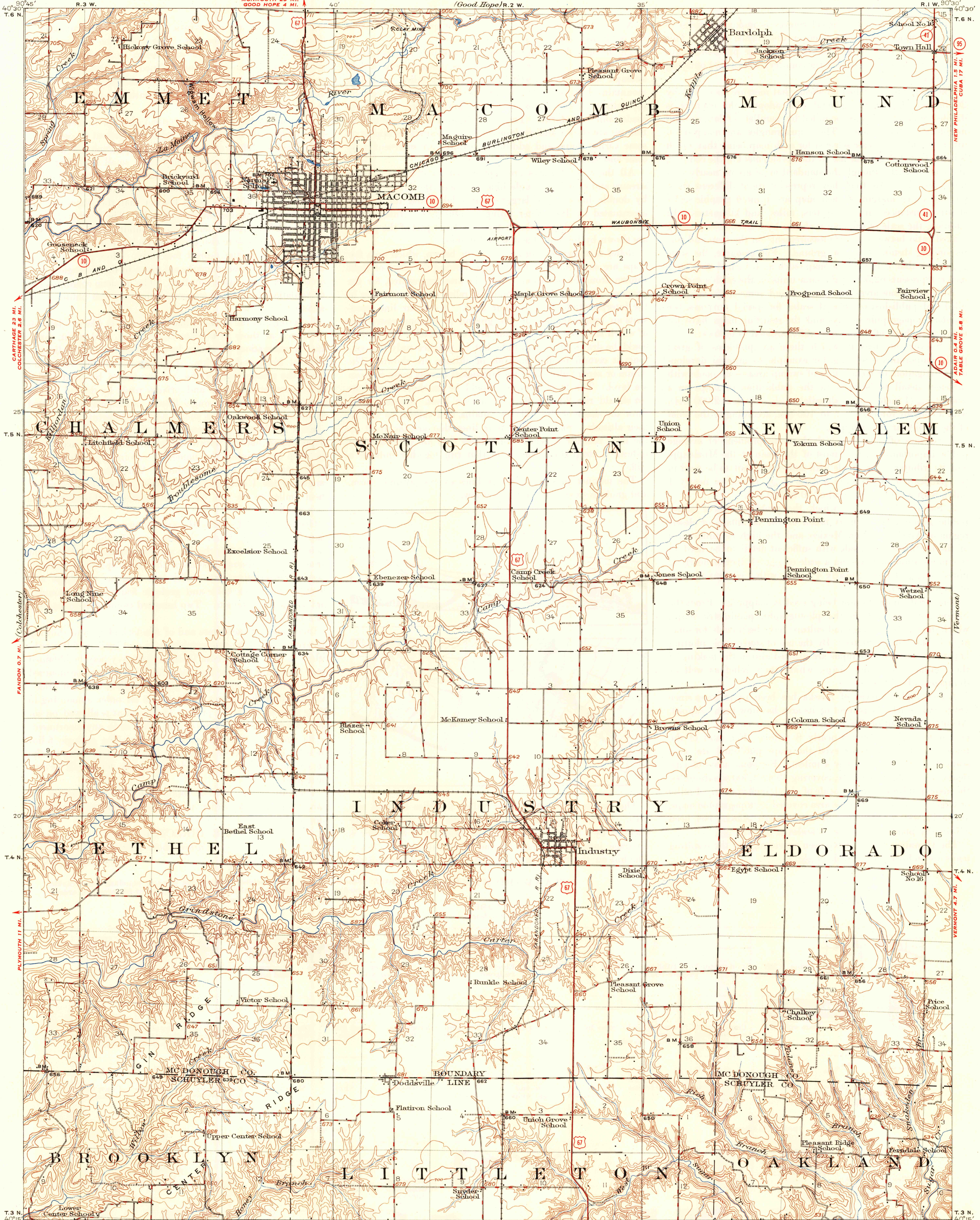

MACOMB QUADRANGLE

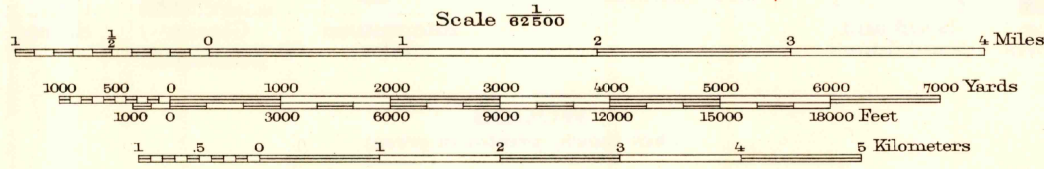
