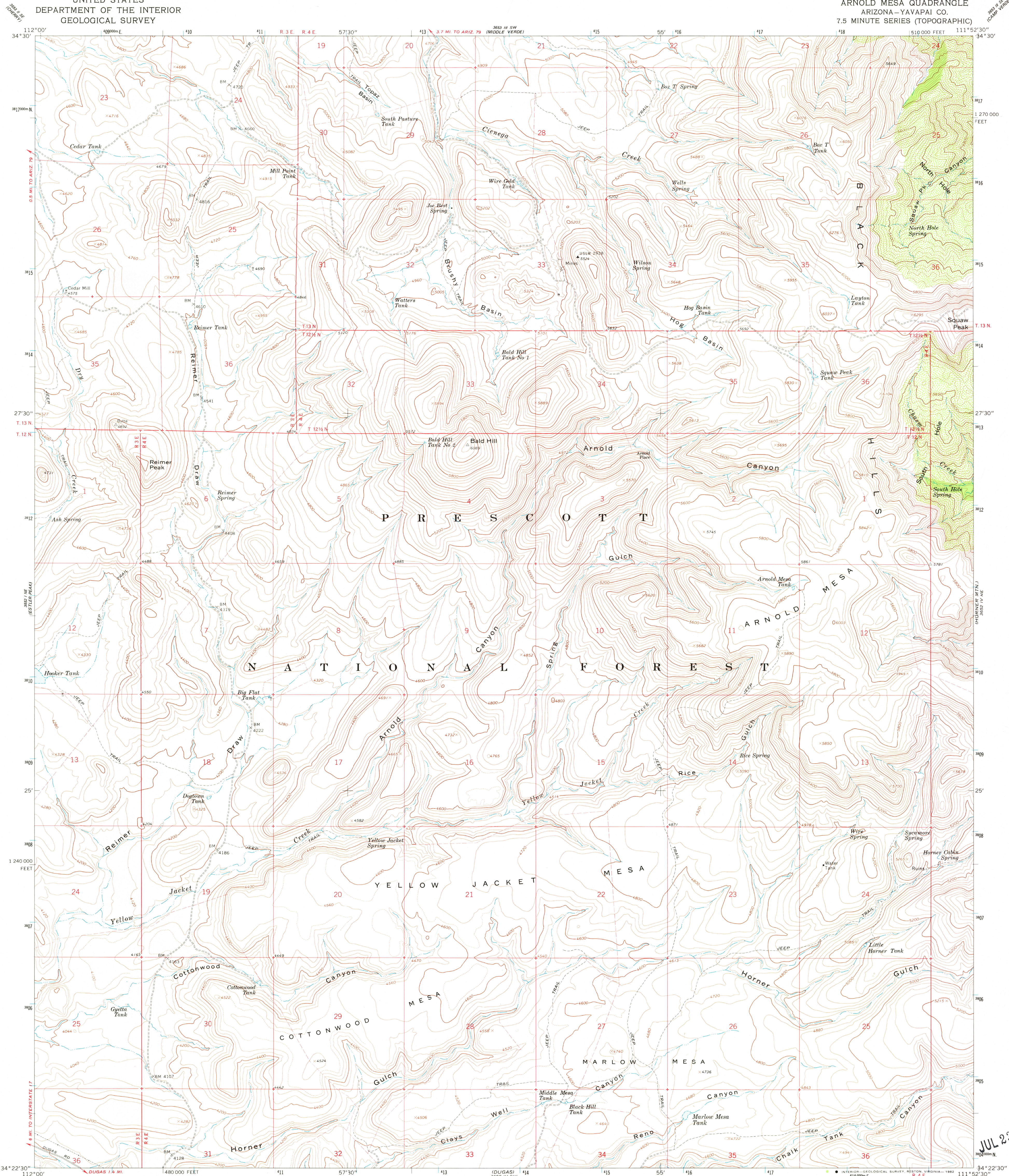

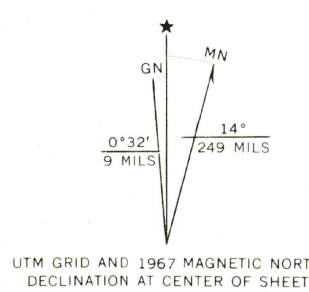

Fine red dashed lines indicate selected fence lines

Where omitted, land lines have not been established
