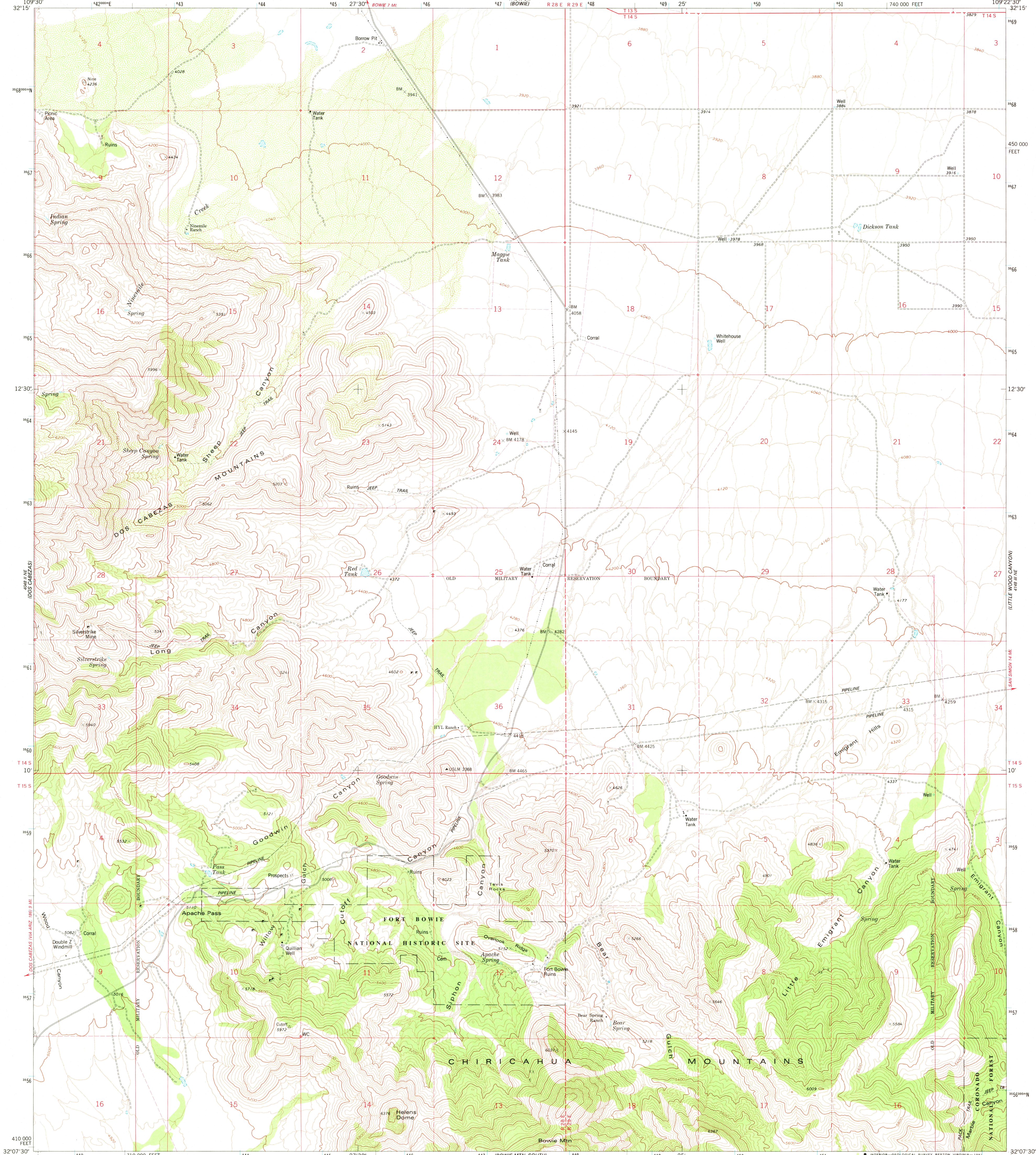

1000-meter Universal Transverse Mercator grid ticks, zone 12, shown in blue. 1927 North American datum

To place on the predicted North American Datum 1983 move the projection lines 8 meters south and 59 meters east as shown by dashed corner ticks

A portion of the northeast quarter of this map lies within a subsidence area

Vertical control based on latest available adjustment

Where omitted, land lines have not been established

There may be private inholdings within the boundaries of the National or State reservations shown on this map
