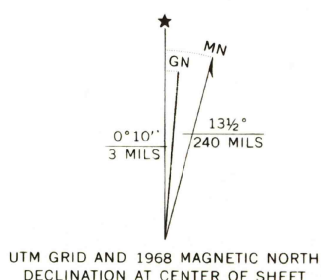

10,000-foot grids based on Arizona coordinate system, central and east zones
1000-meter Universal Transverse Mercator grid ticks, zone 12, shown in blue
To place on the predicted North American Datum 1983 move the projection lines 3 meters north and 61 meters east as shown by dashed corner ticks
Fine red dashed lines indicate selected fence lines
Where omitted, land lines have not been established
