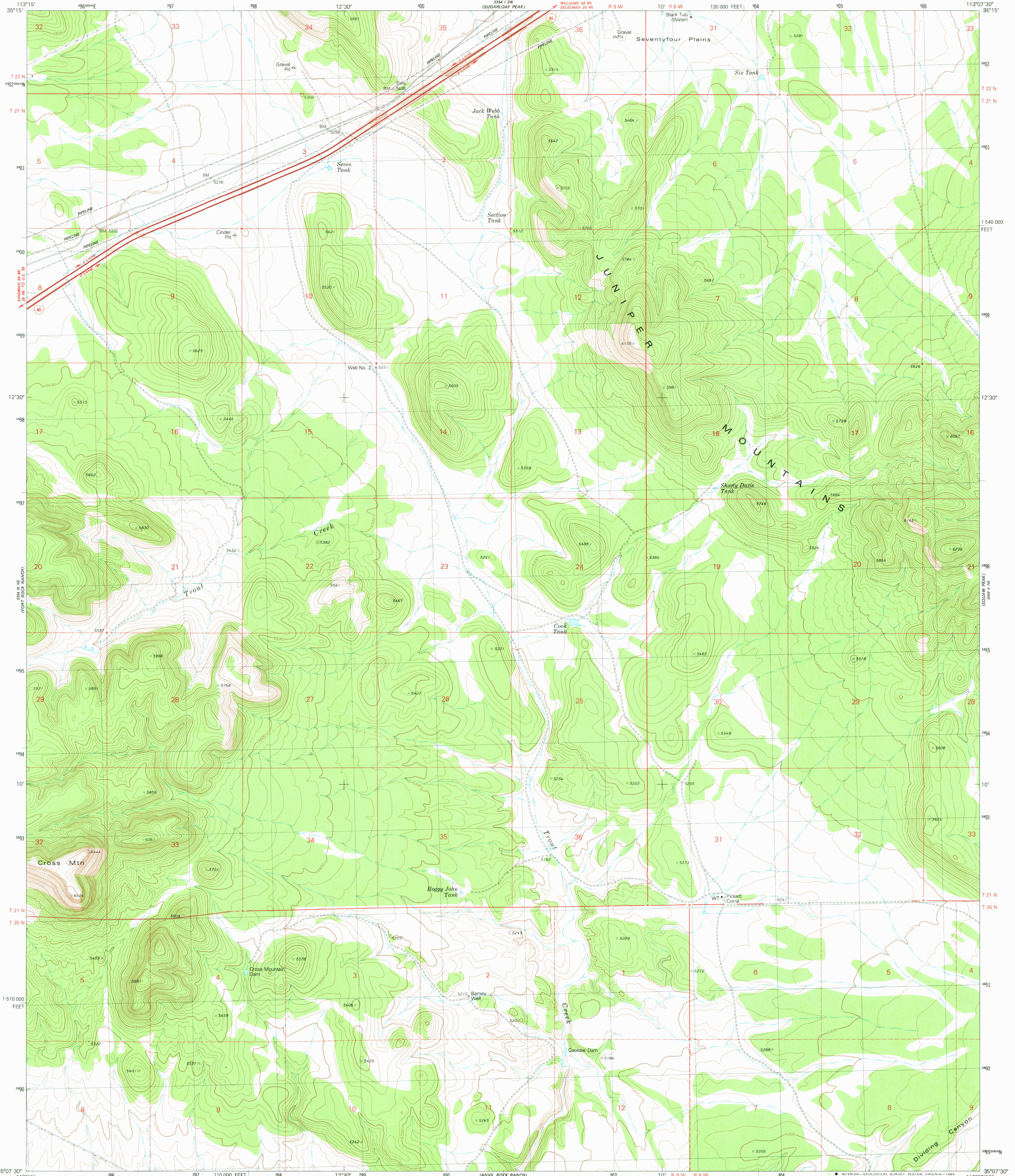

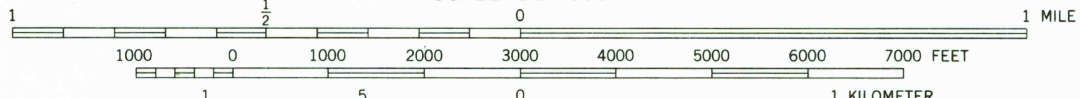
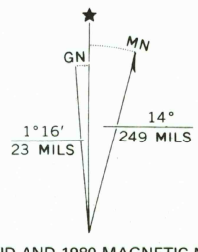
Projection and 10,000-foot grid ticks: Arizona coordinate system, central zone (transverse Mercator)
