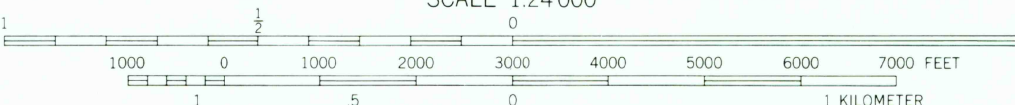
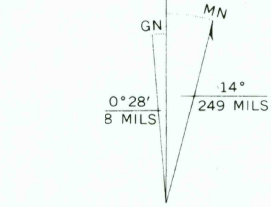

corner ticks

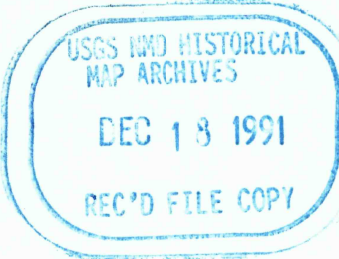
