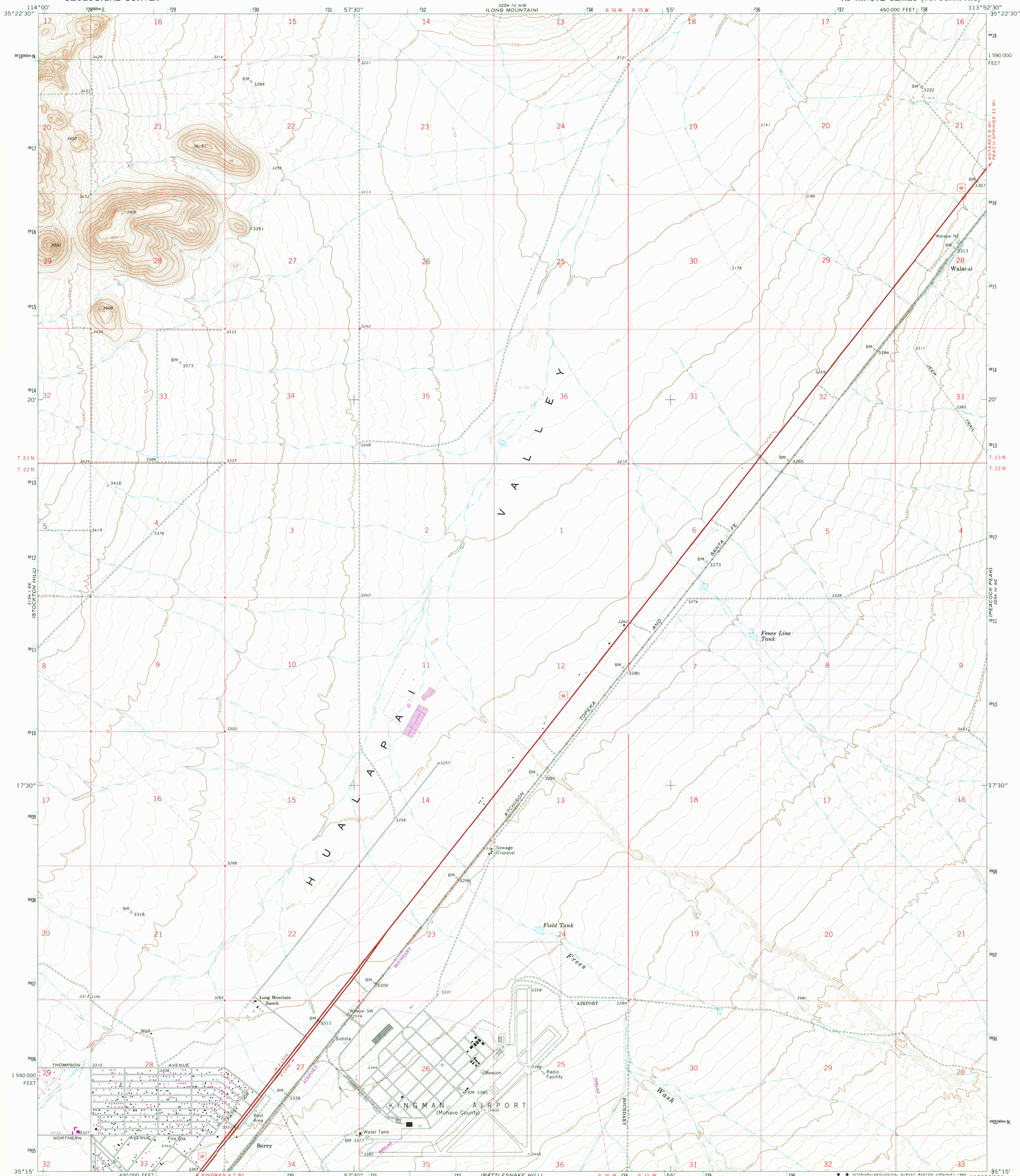

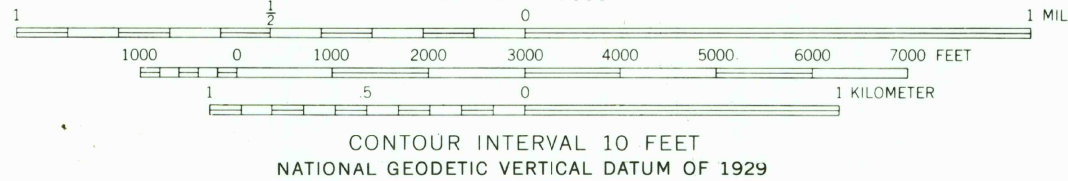
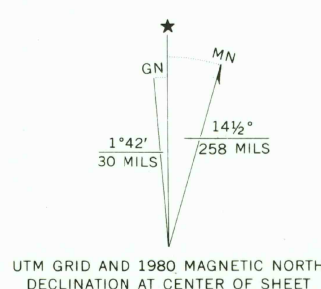

move the projection lines 2 meters north and
71 meters east as shown by dashed corner ticks

Fine red dashed lines indicate selected fence lines
