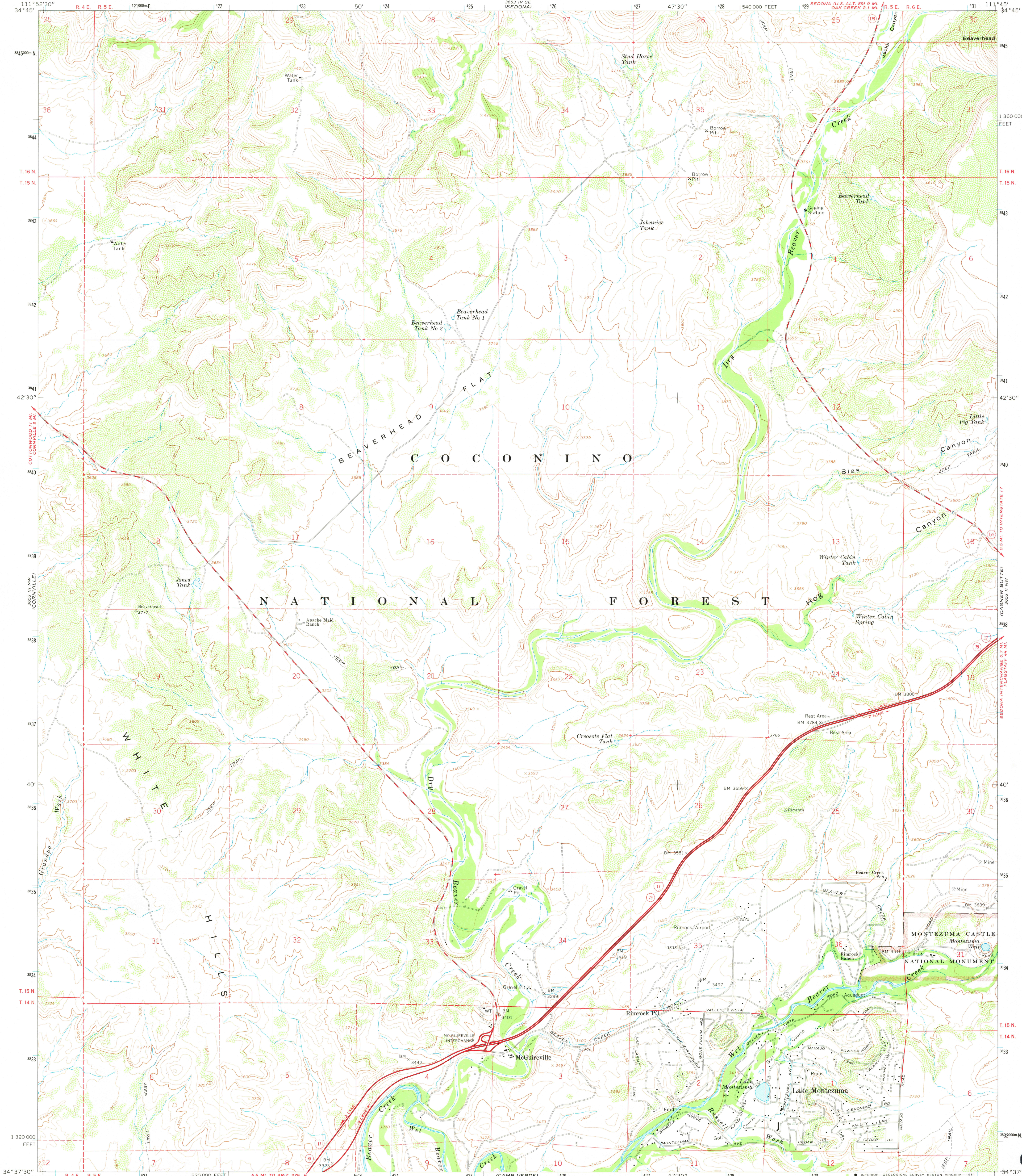

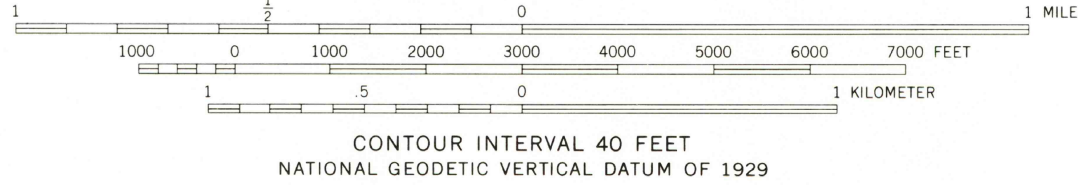
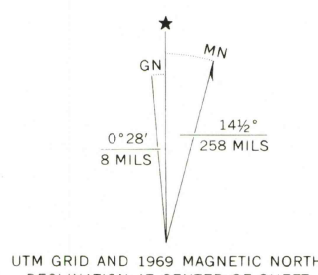
LAKE MONTEZUMA QUADRANGLE
