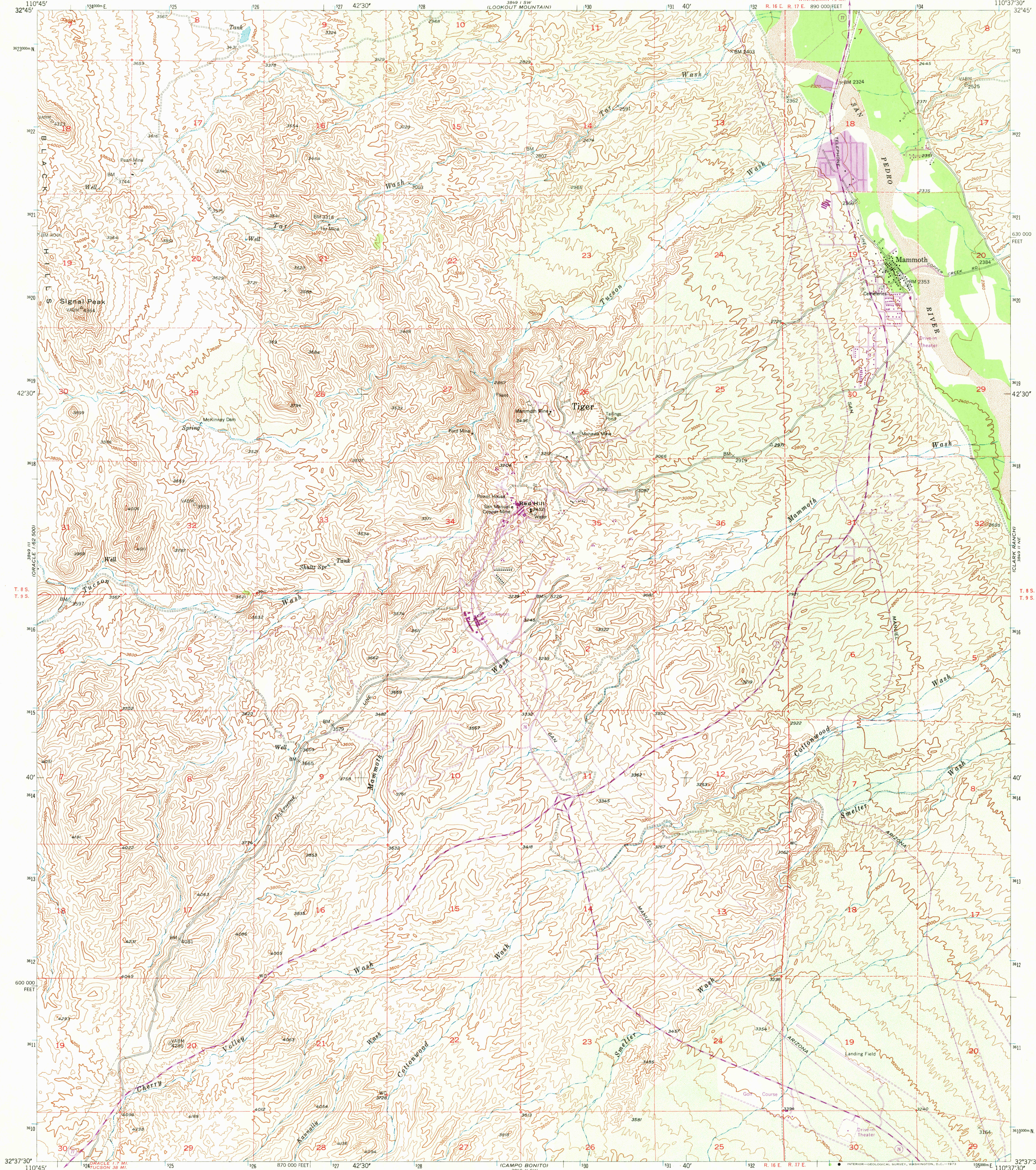

central zone

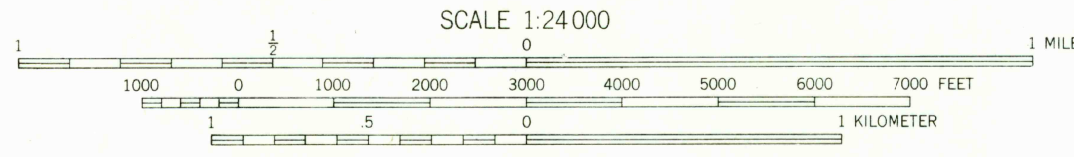
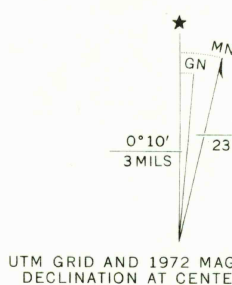
Dashed land lines indicate approximate location
