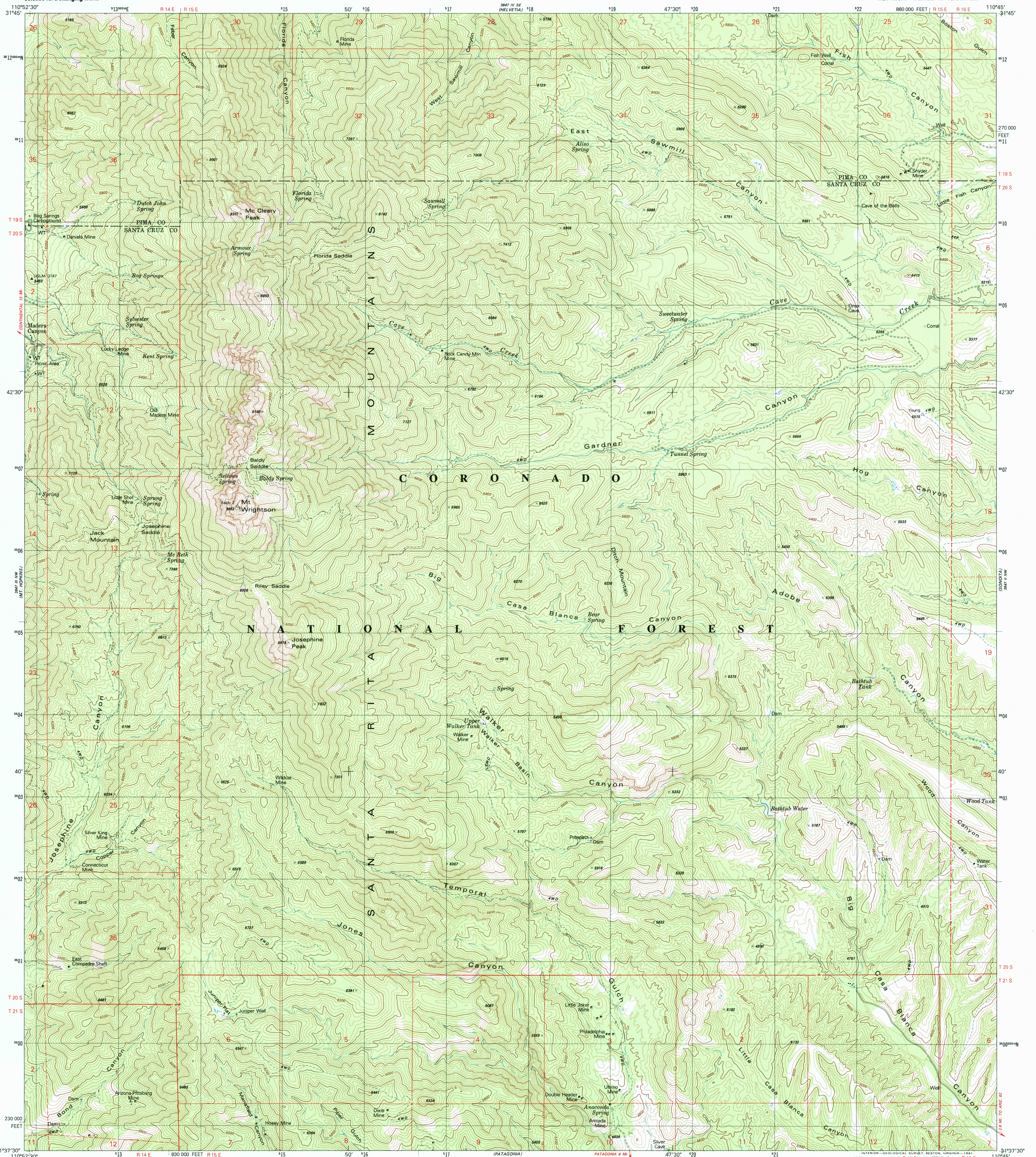

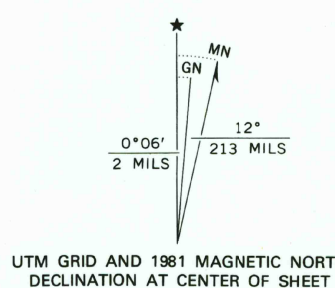

1927 North American Datum

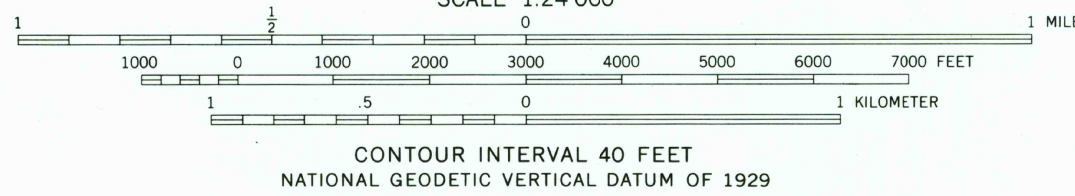
To place on the predicted North American Datum 1983
