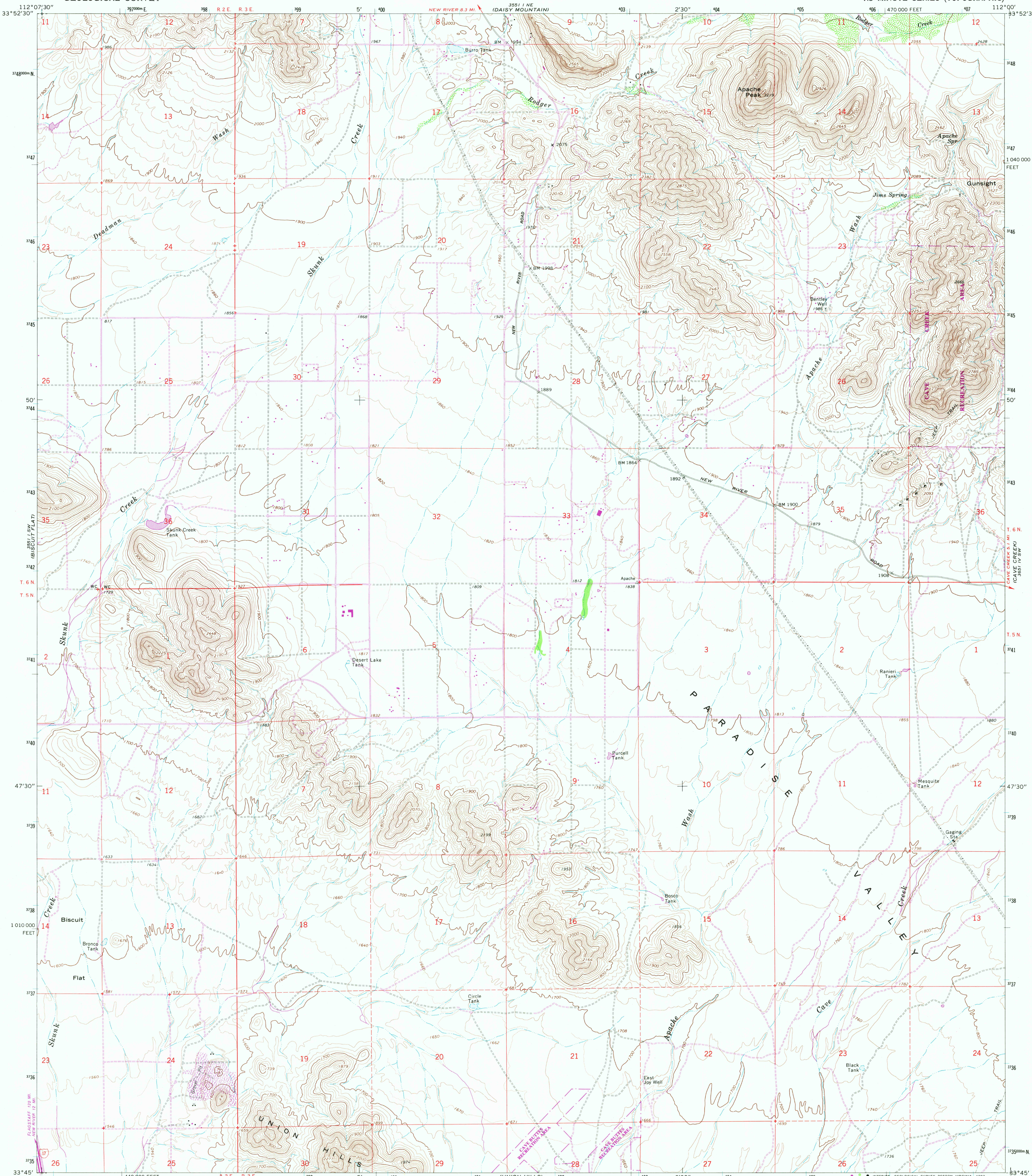

Polyconic projection, 10,000-foot grid ticks based on Arizona coordinate system, central zone

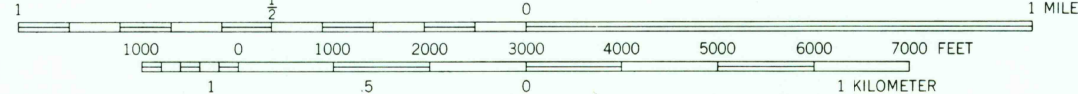
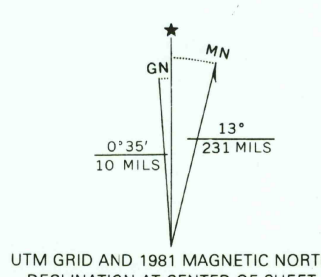
1000-meter Universal Transverse Mercator grid ticks, zone 12, shown in blue, 1927 North American Datum
