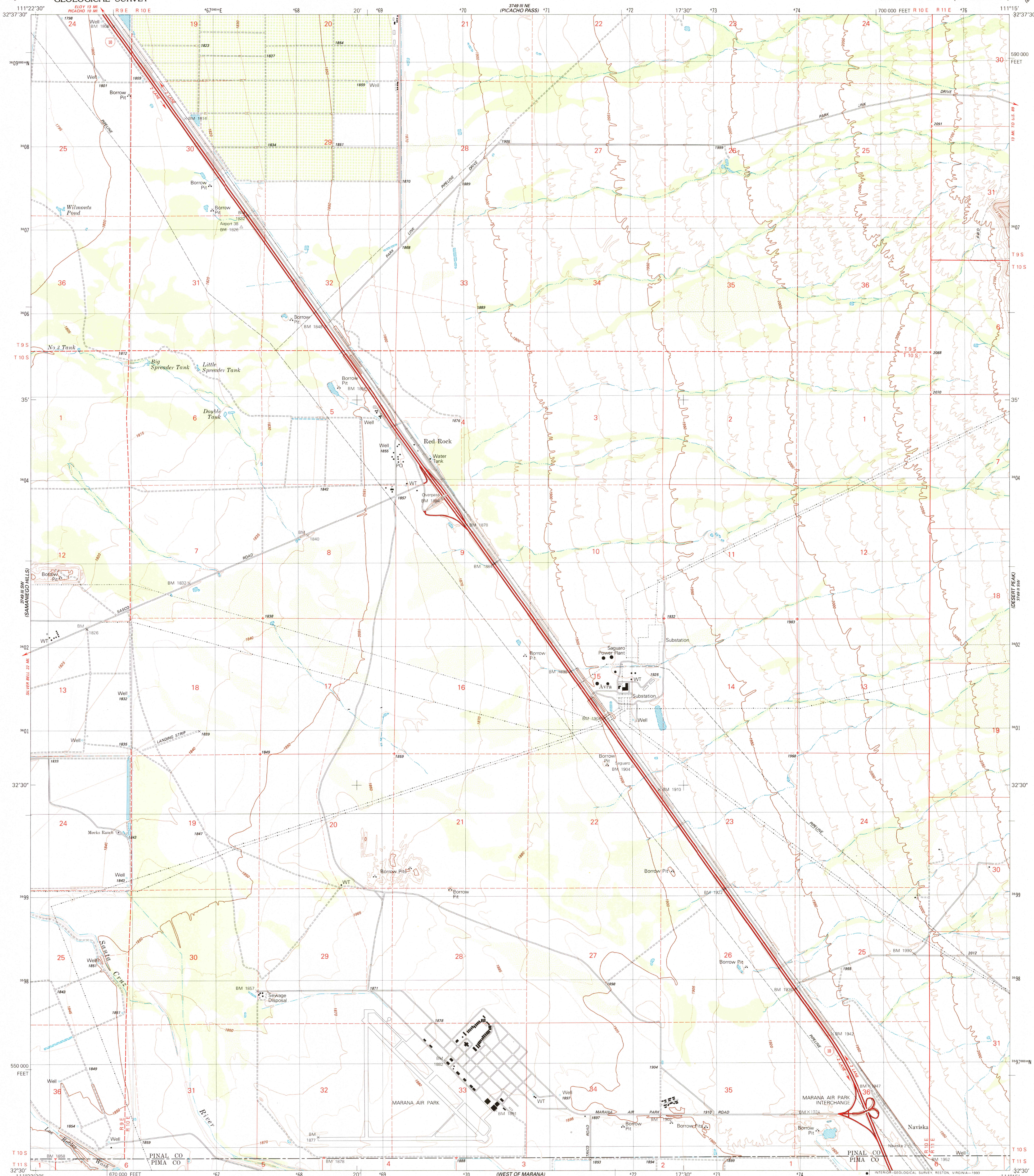

Mercator grid, zone 12

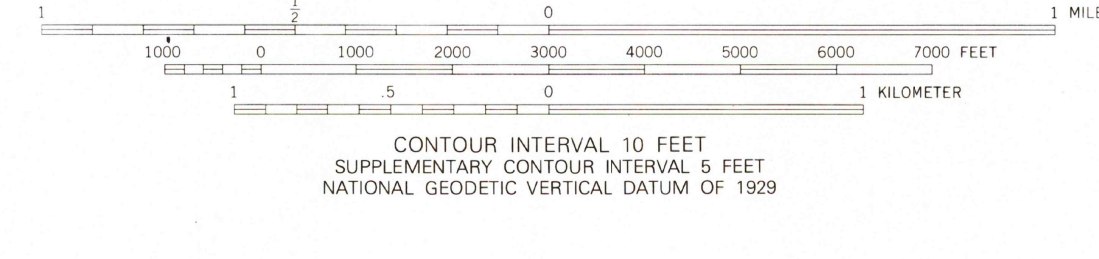
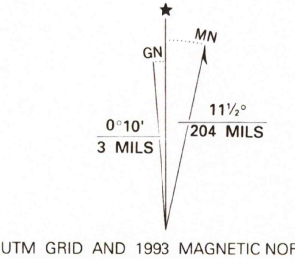
The difference between NAD 27 and North American Datum of
