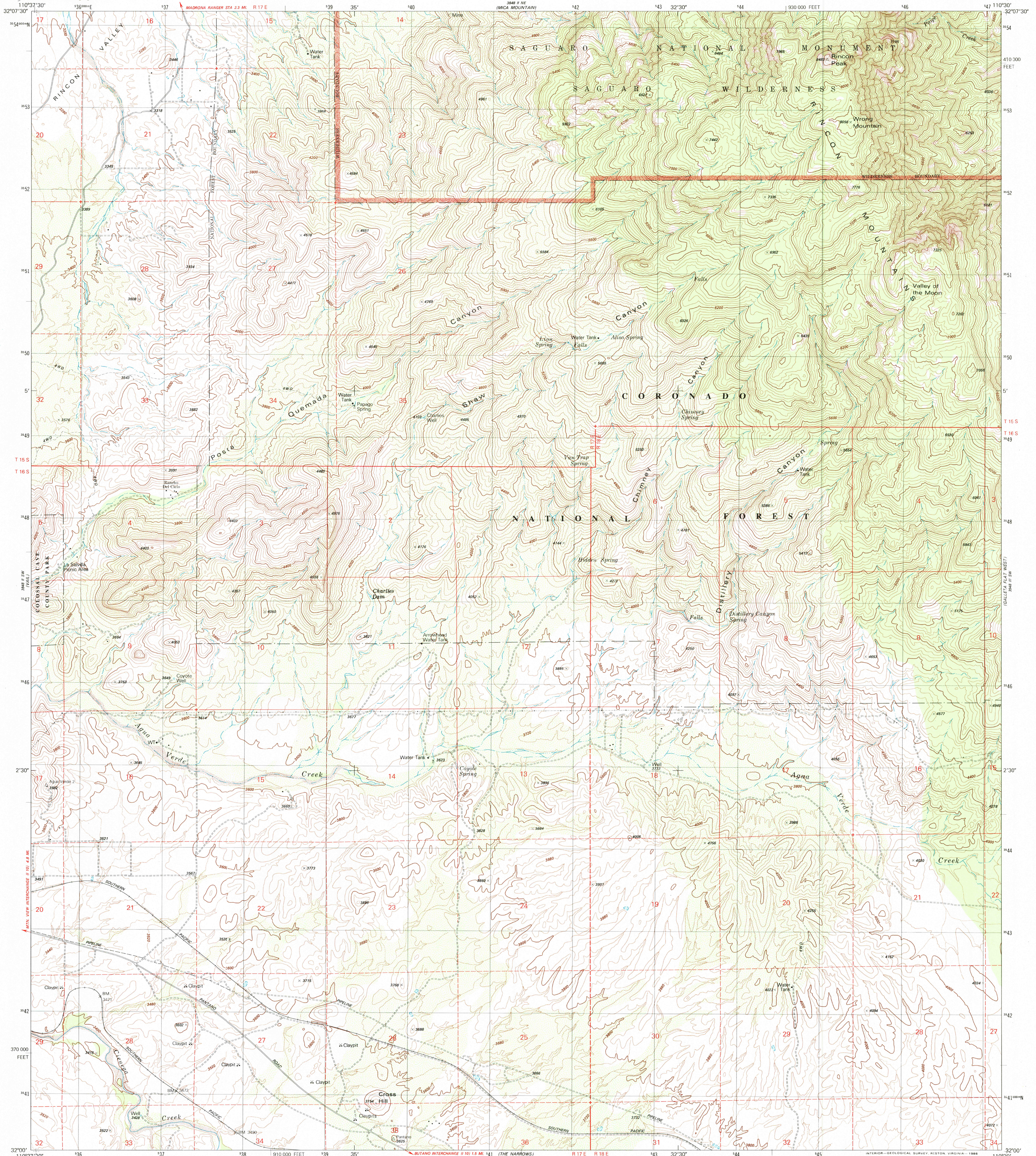

1000-meter Universal Transverse Mercator grid, zone 12

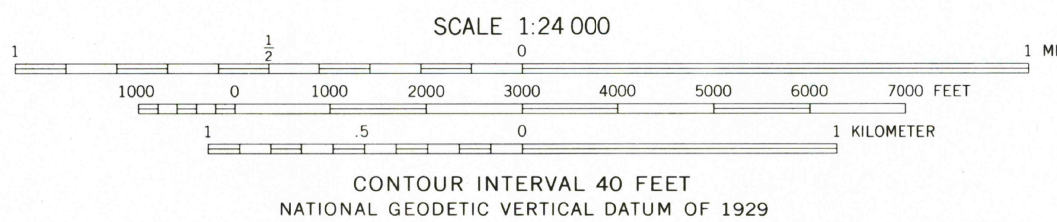
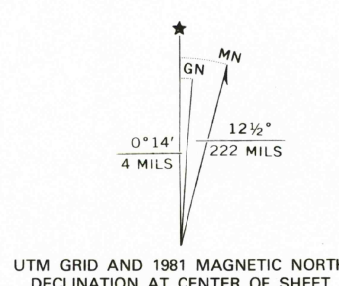
1927 North American Datum
