

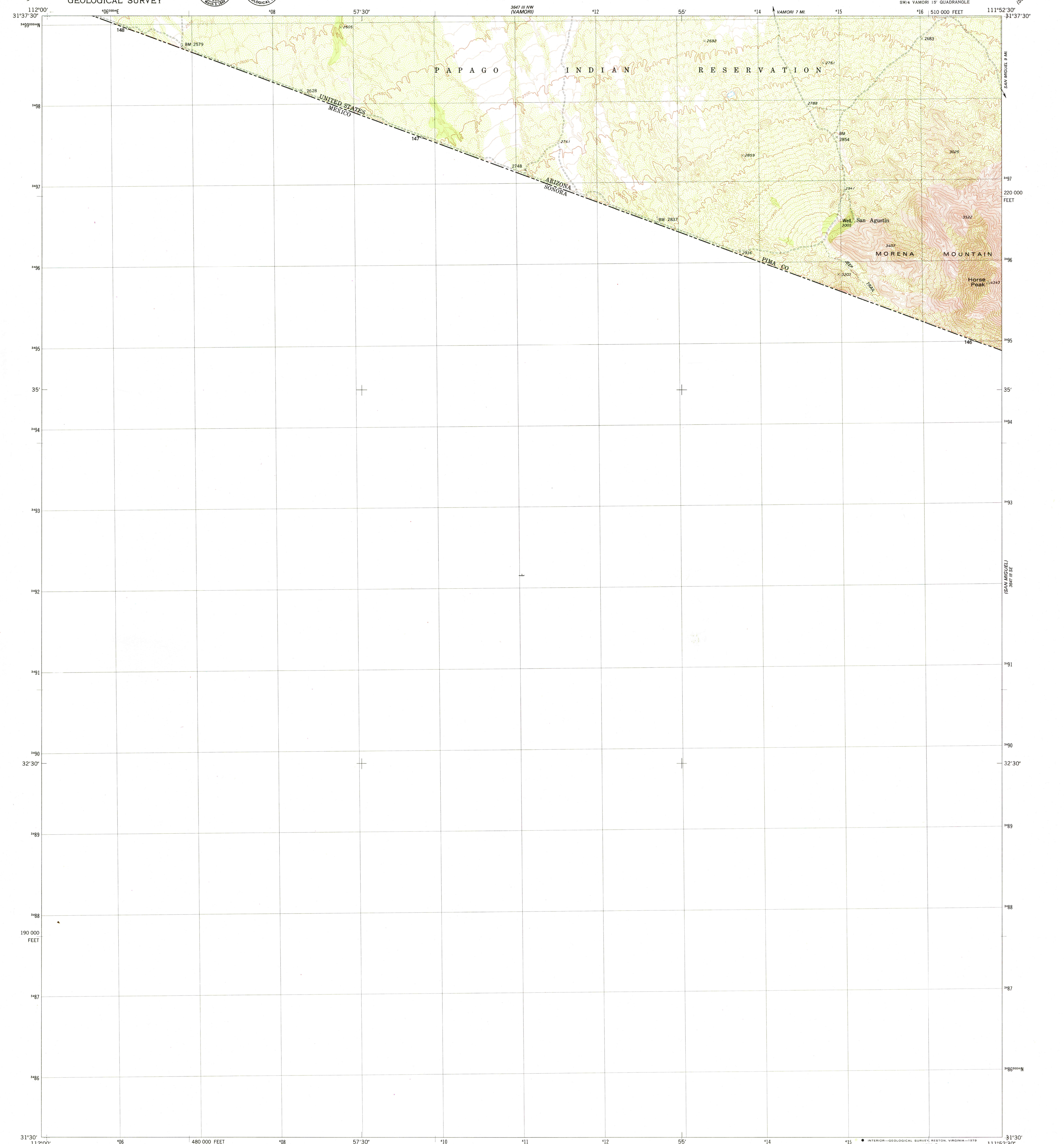

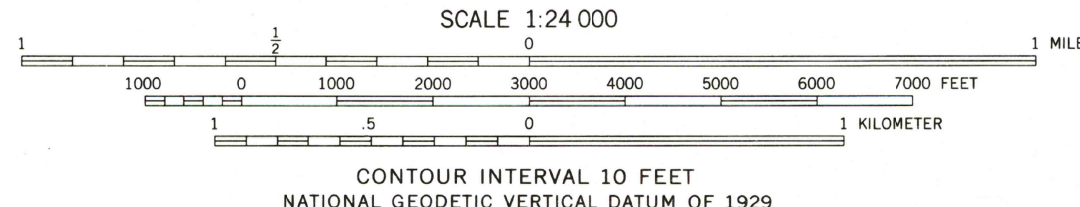
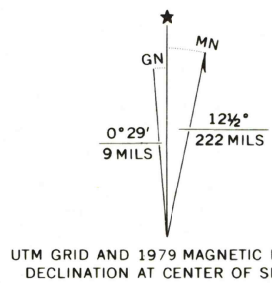


SAN AGUSTIN QUADRANGLE
