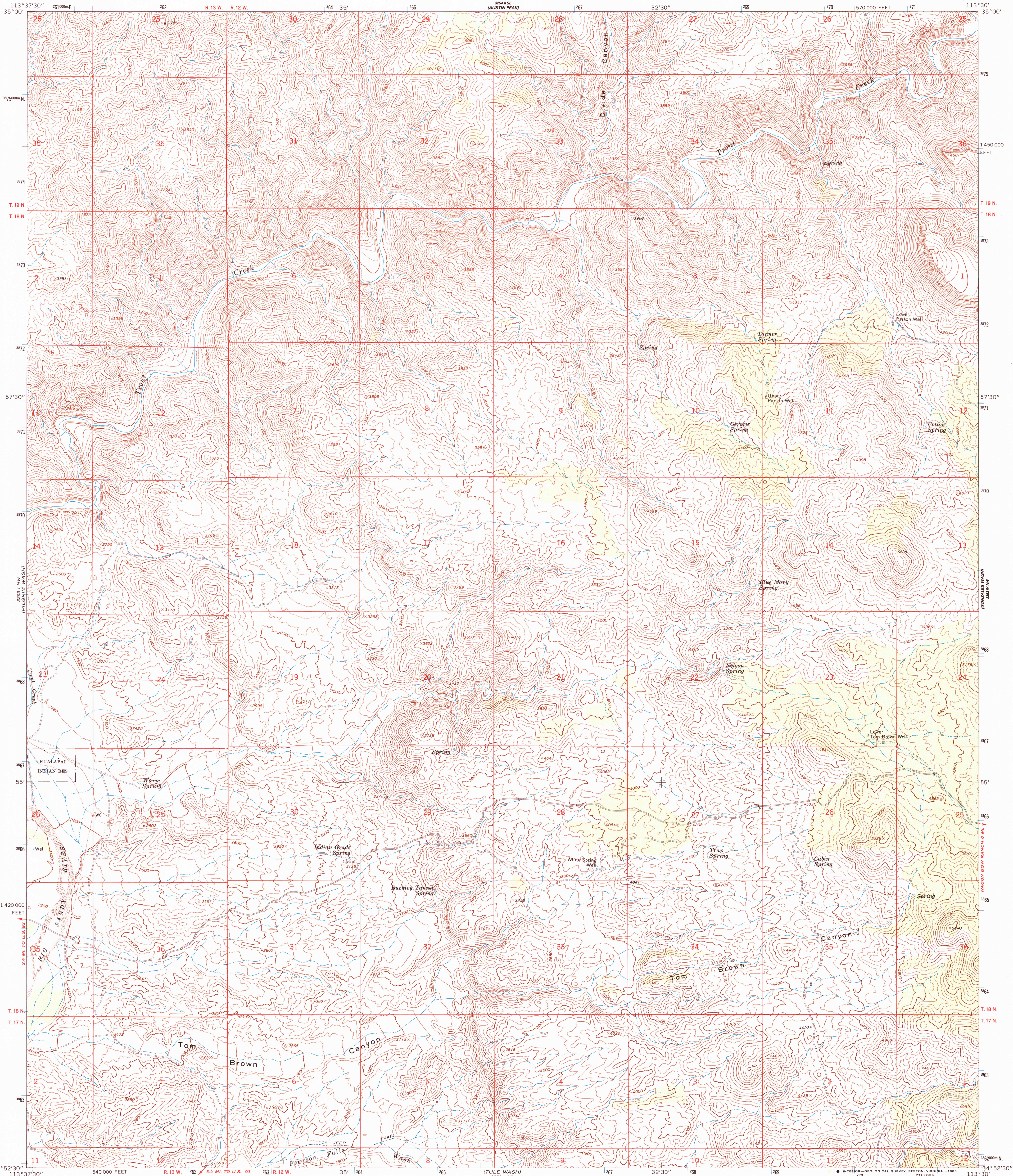

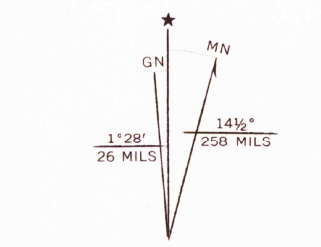

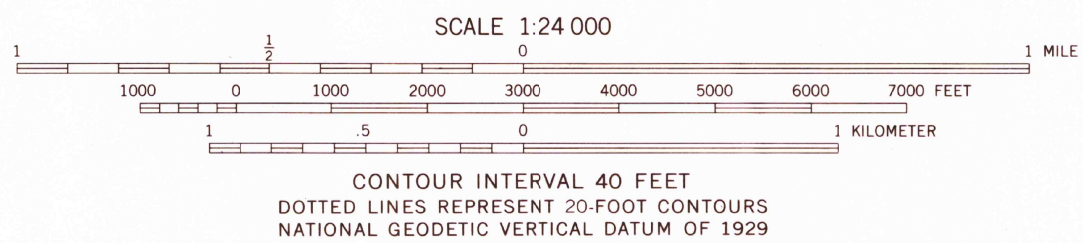

To place on the predicted North American Datum 1983 move the projection lines 1 meter north and 70 meters east as shown by dashed corner ticks

Fine red dashed lines indicate selected fence lines
