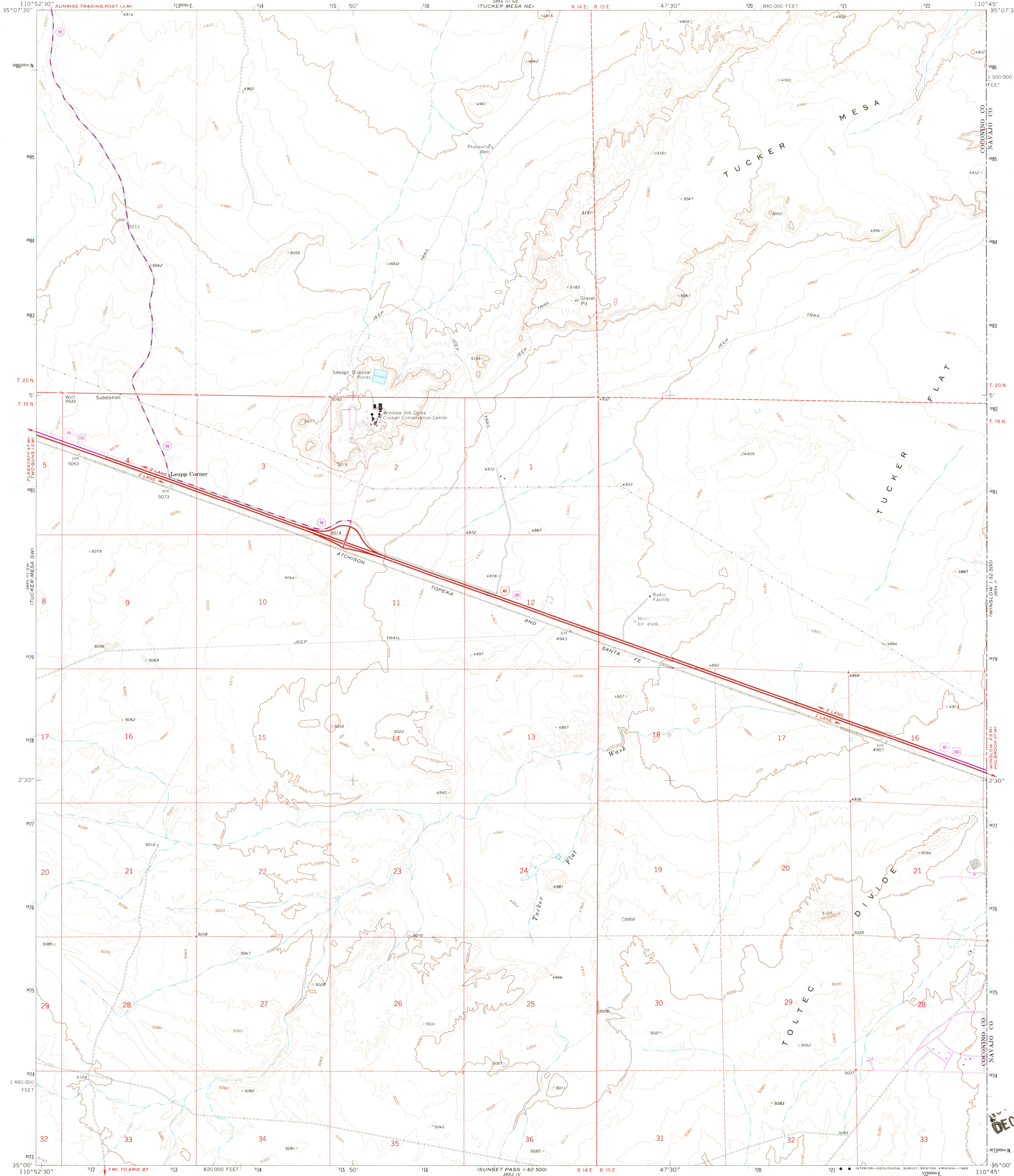
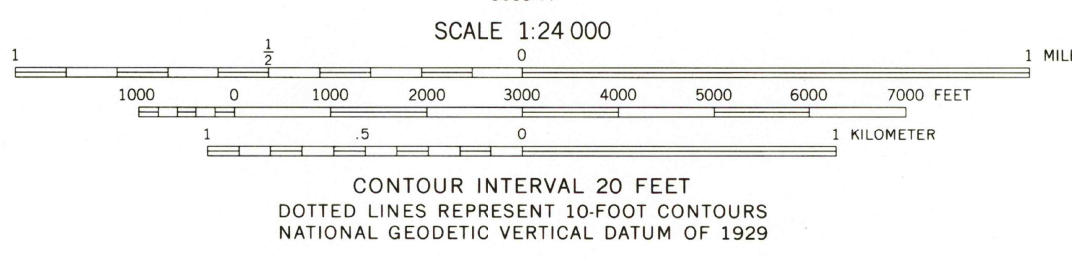
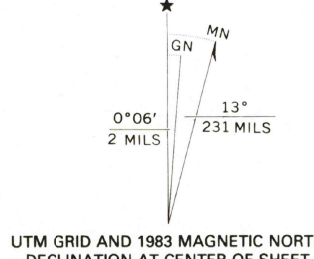

Certain land lines have been omitted because of insufficient data

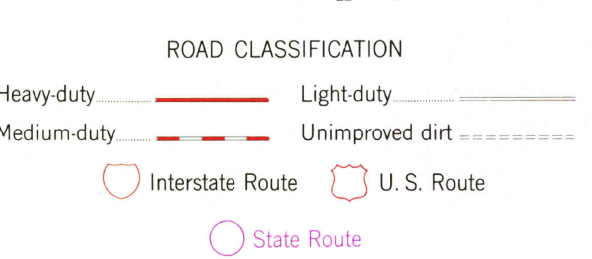


CONTOUR INTERVAL 20 FEET
