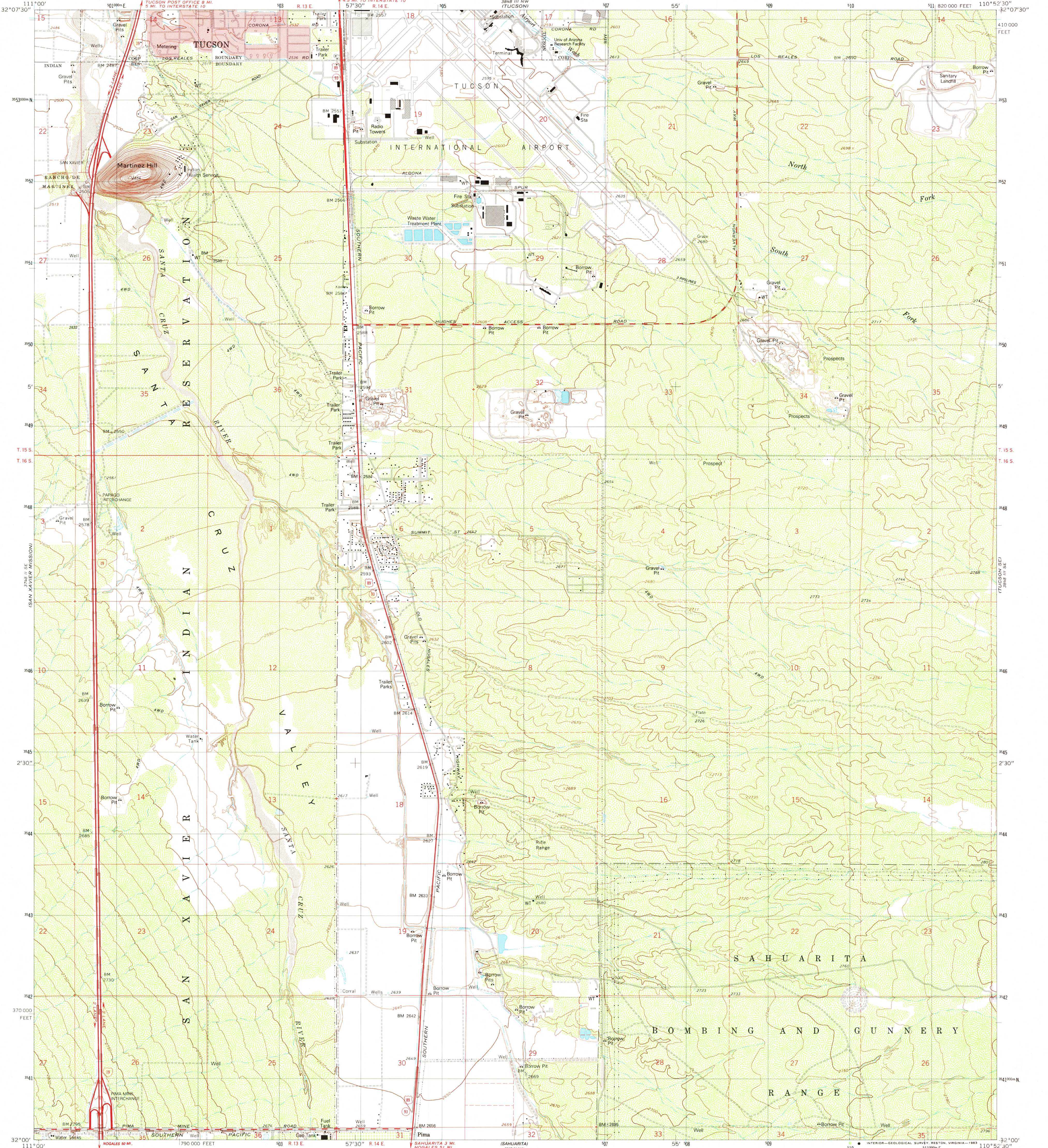

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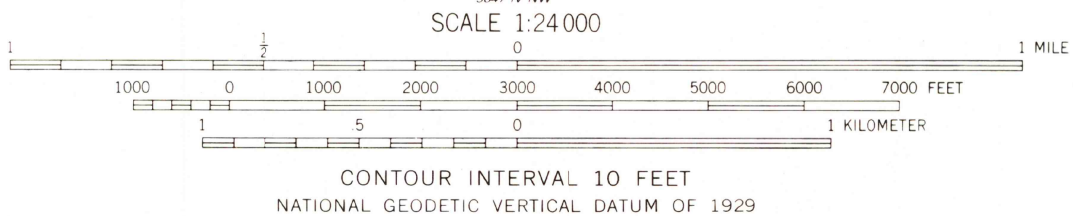
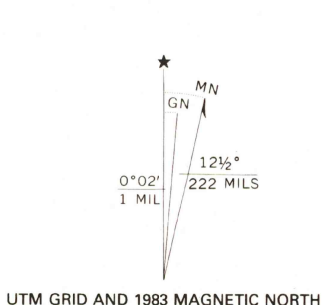

1927 North American Datum

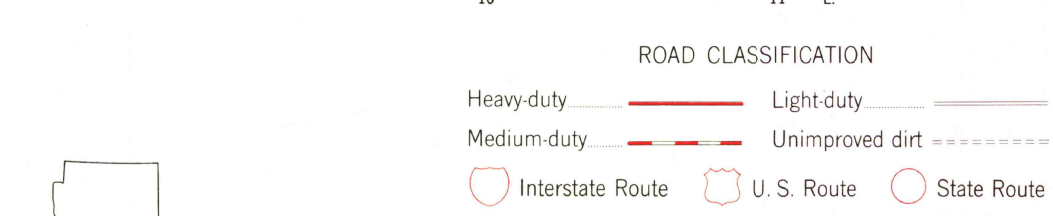
To place on the predicted North American Datum 1983 move the projection lines 7 meters south and 62 meters east as shown by dashed corner ticks
