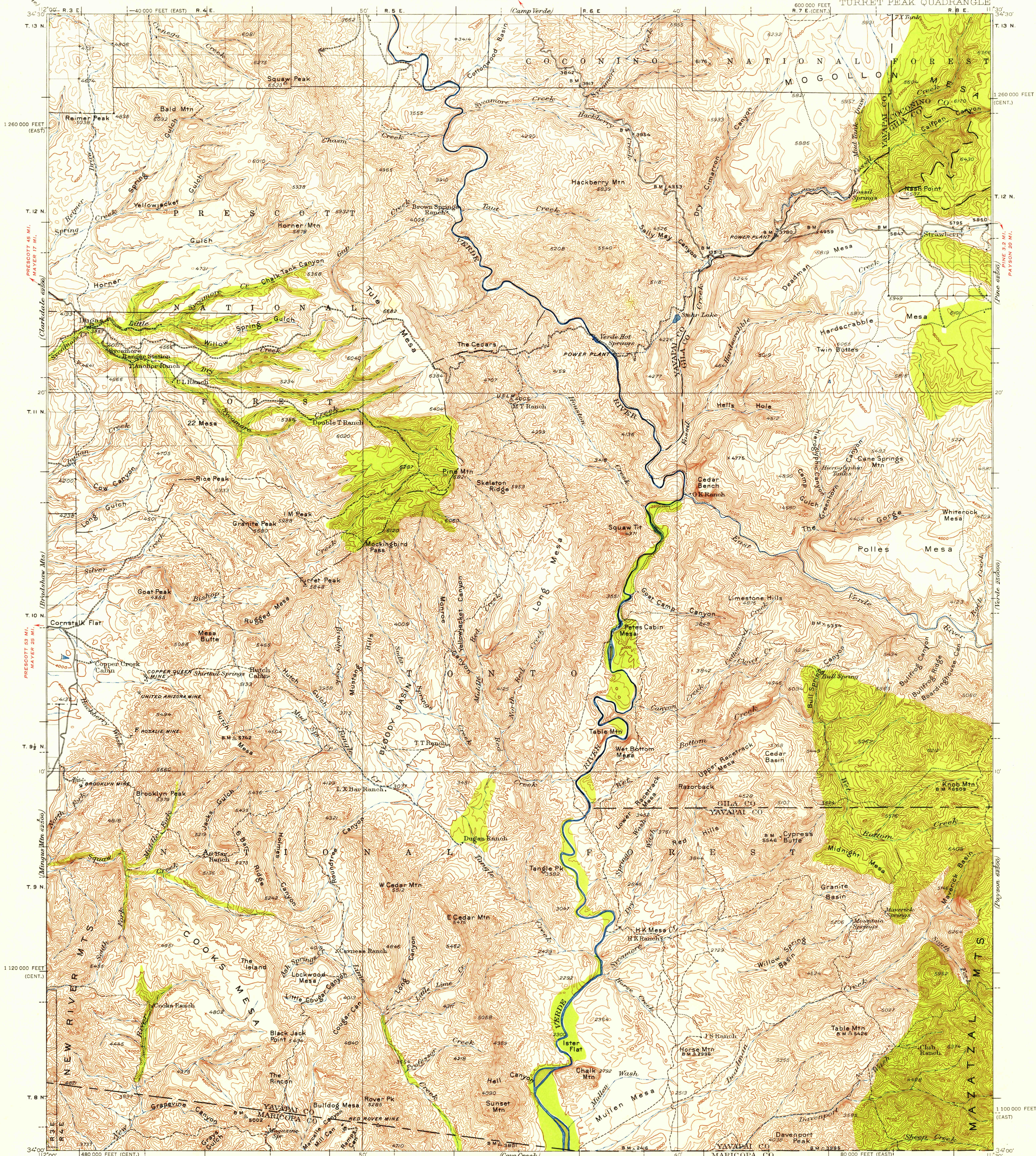

TURRET PEAK QUADRANGLE

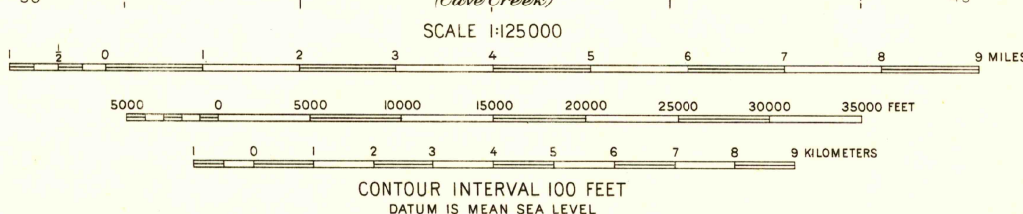
