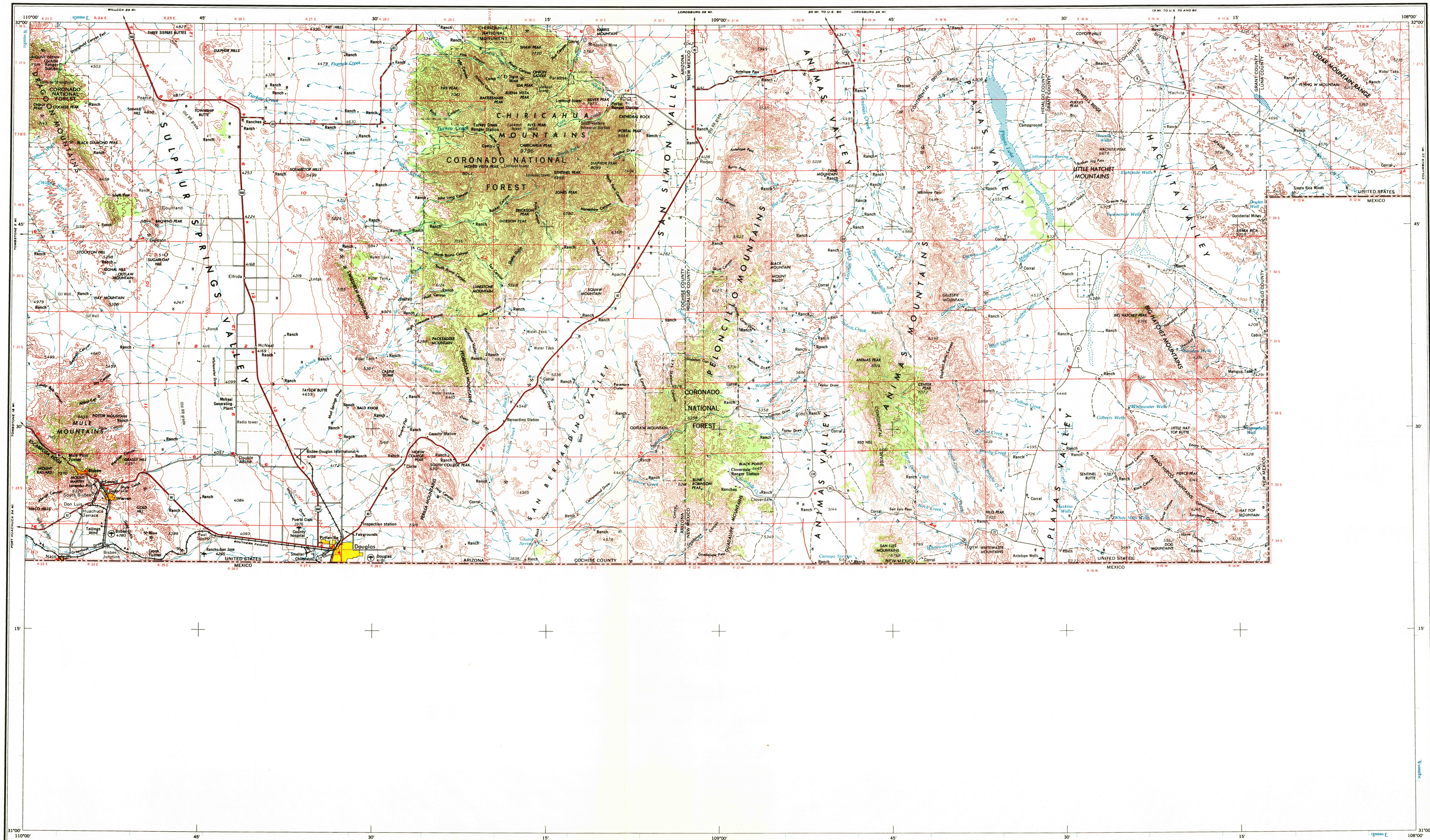
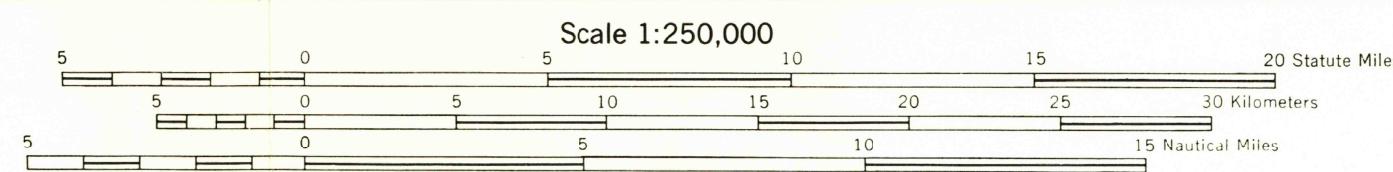
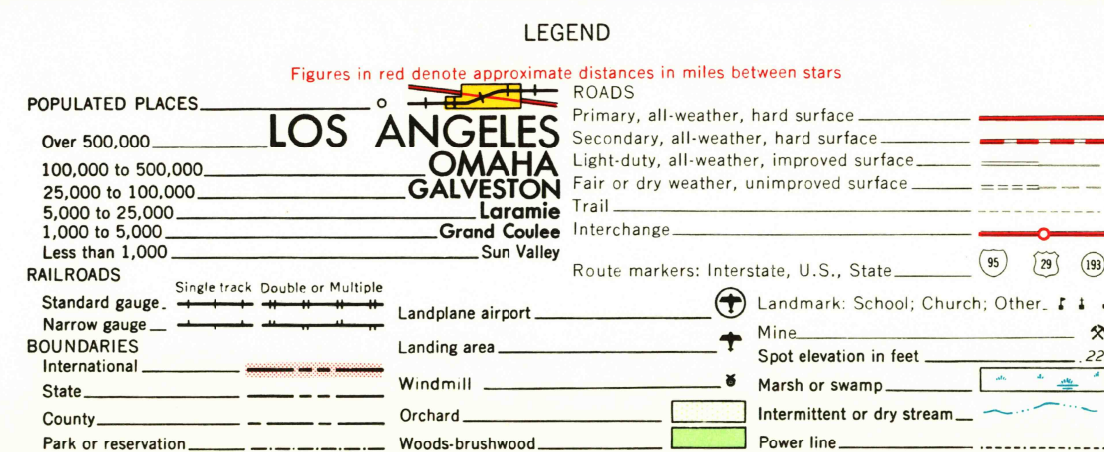

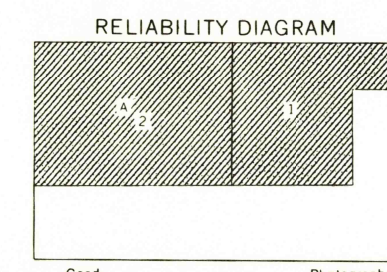
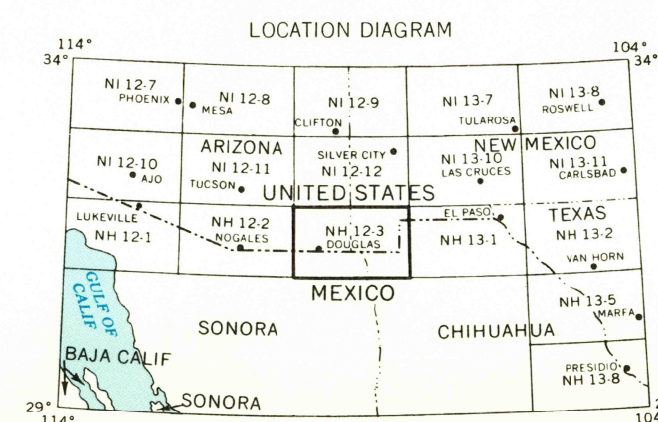
10,000-meter Universal Transverse Mercator grid ticks, zone 12, shown in blue.
