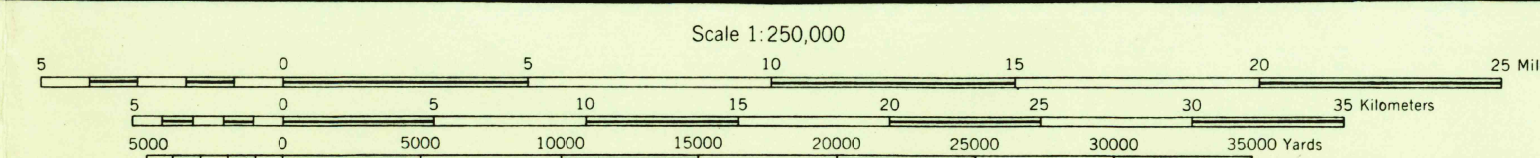
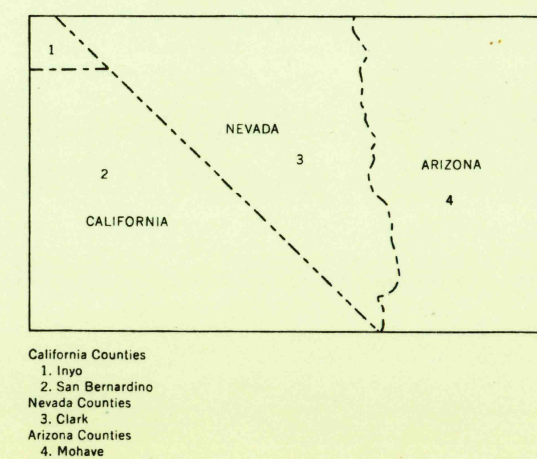

INDEX TO BOUNDARIES



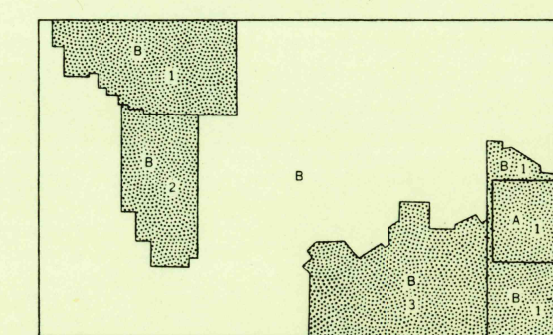
