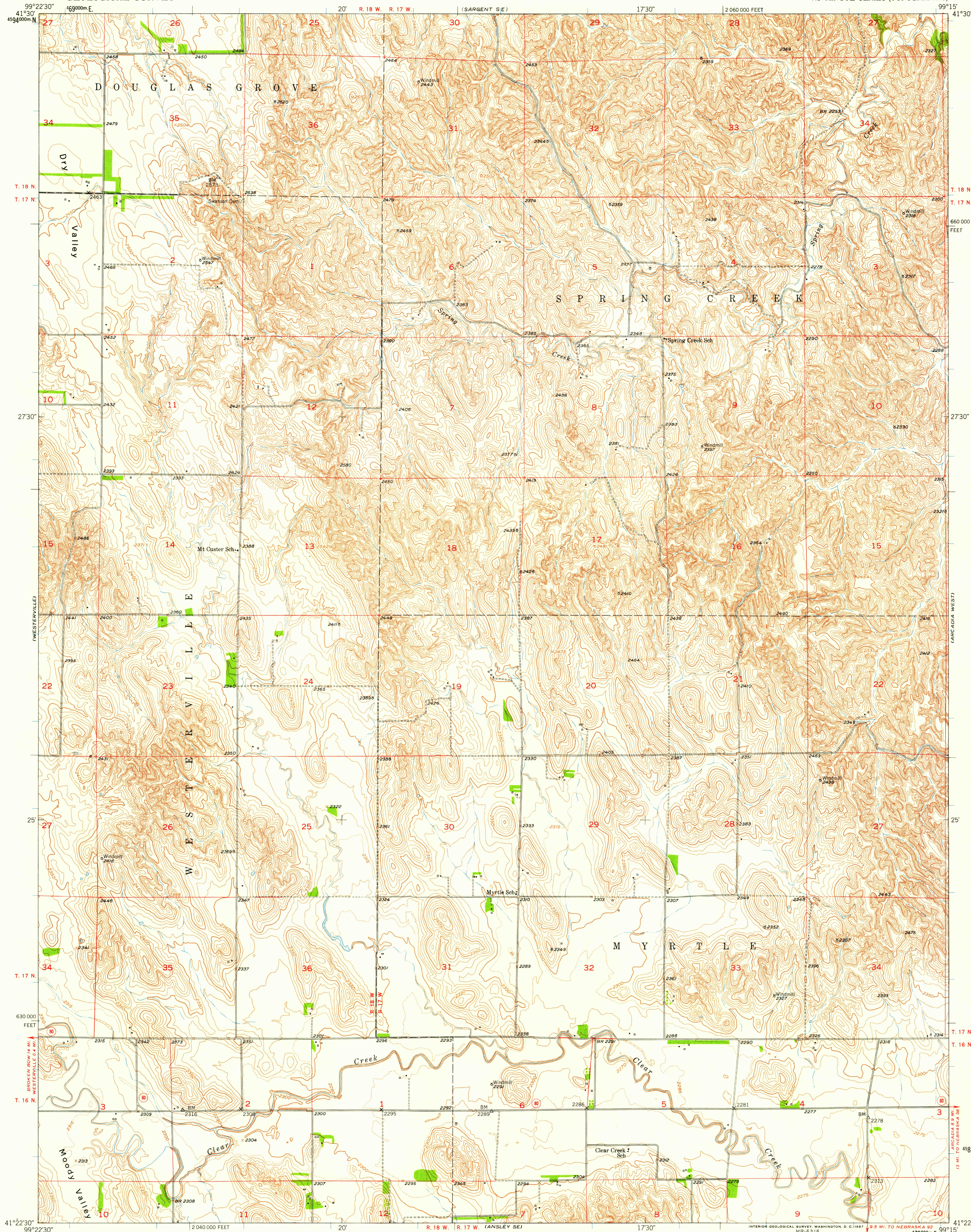

Topography by multiplex methods from aerial photographs taken 1949 and in part by U. S. Bureau of Reclamation. Field check 1951.

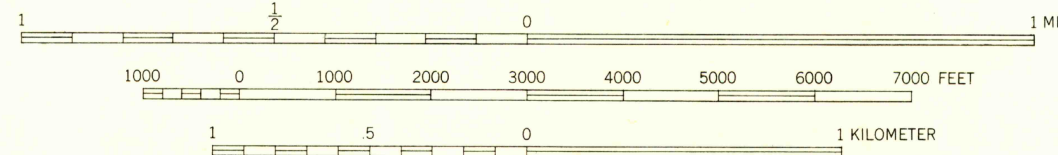
Polyconic projection. 1927 North American datum.
