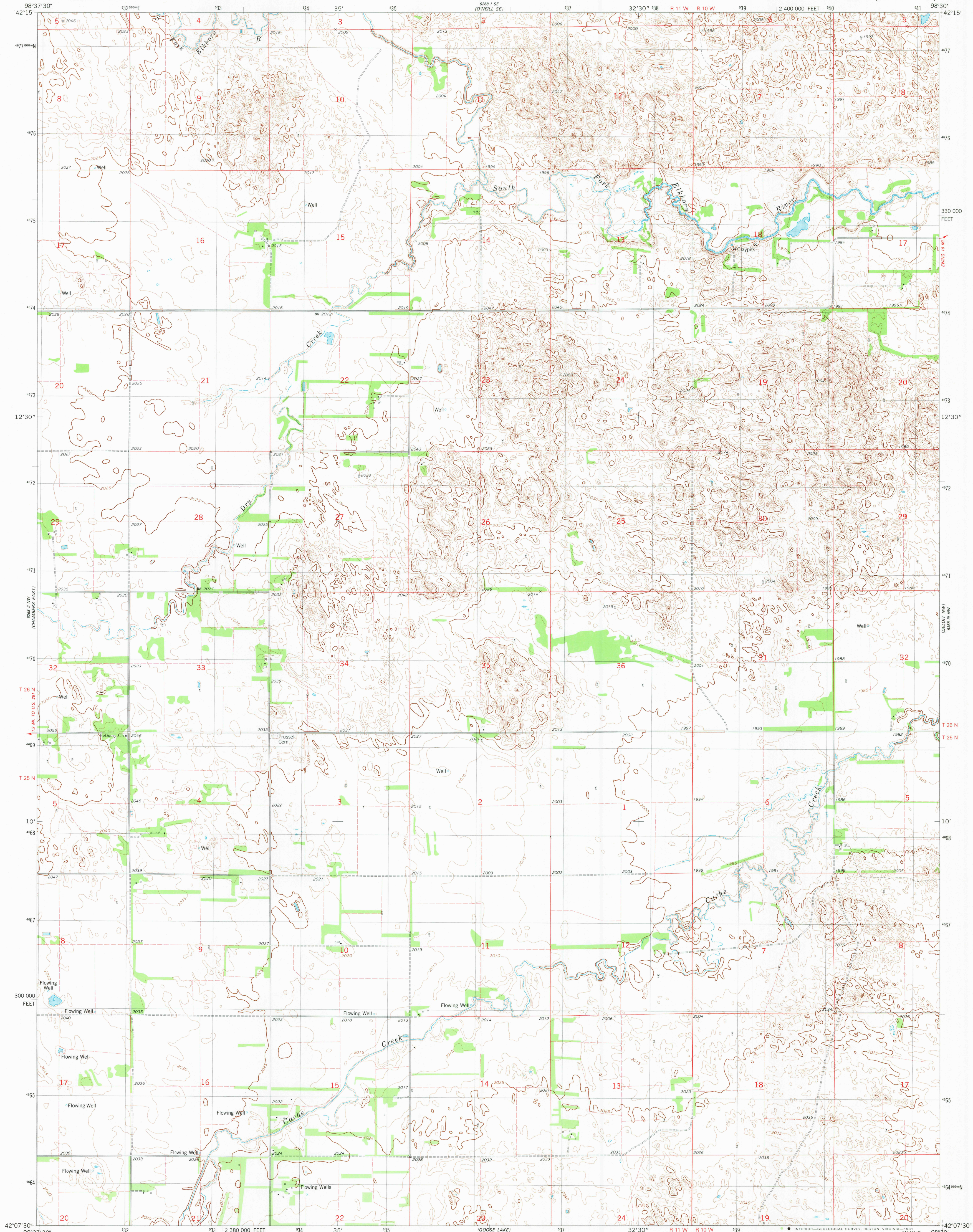

1000-meter Universal Transverse Mercator grid, zone 14

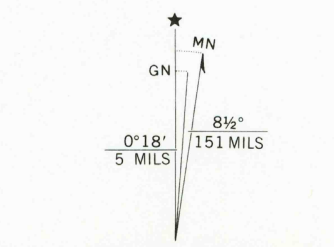
1927 North American Datum
