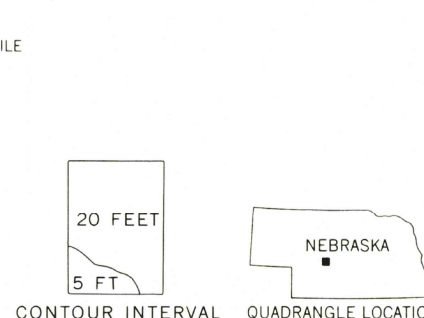
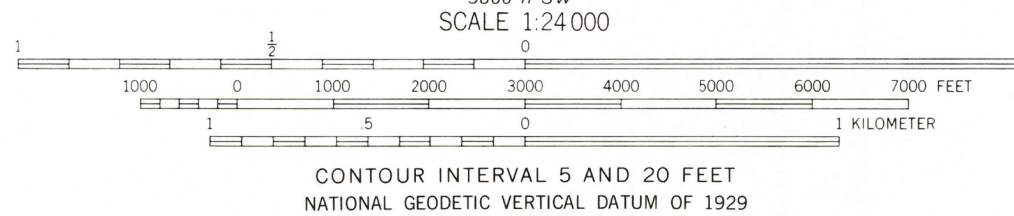
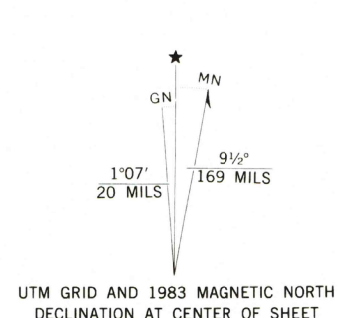
NORTH PLATTE EAST QUADRANGLE

move the projection lines 5 meters north and
36 meters east as shown by dashed corner ticks
