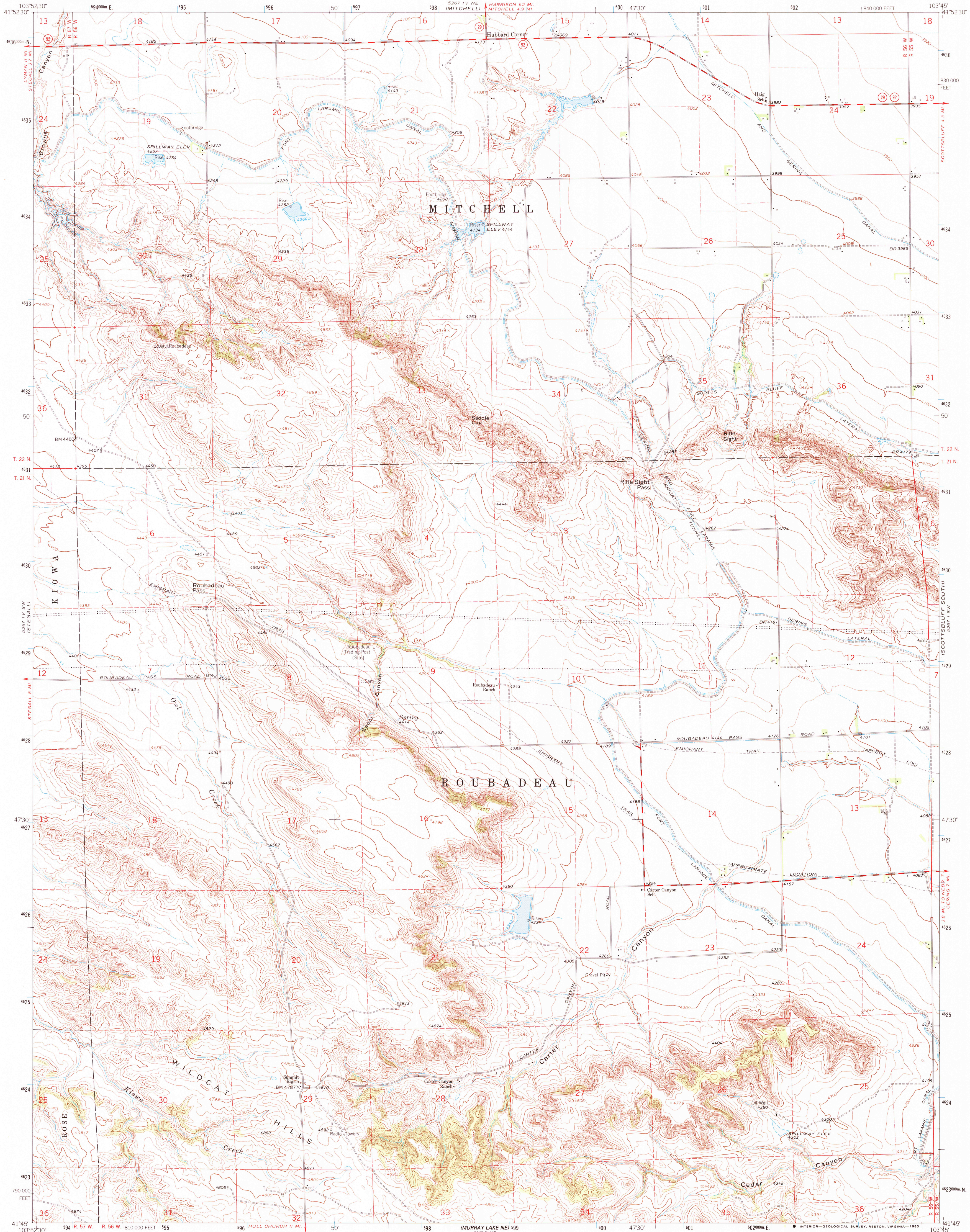

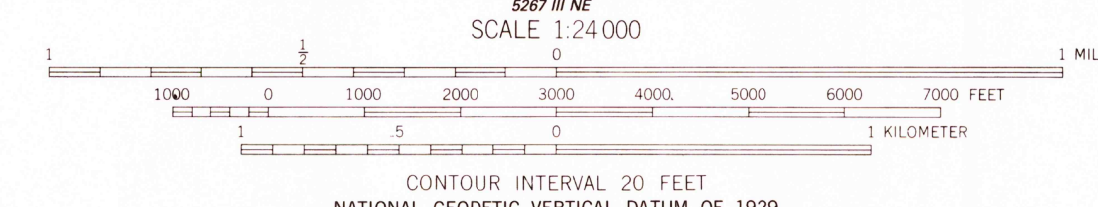
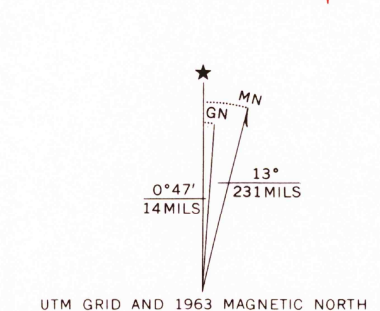

Topography by photogrammetric methods from aerial photographs taken 1962. Field checked 1963.

Polyconic projection. 1927 North American datum 10,000-foot grid based on Nebraska coordinate system, south zone 1000-meter Universal Transverse Mercator grid ticks, zone 13, shown in blue.

To place on the predicted North American Datum 1983, move the projection lines 6 meters north and 44 meters east as shown by dashed corner ticks.

Areas covered by dashed light-blue pattern are subject to controlled inundation.
