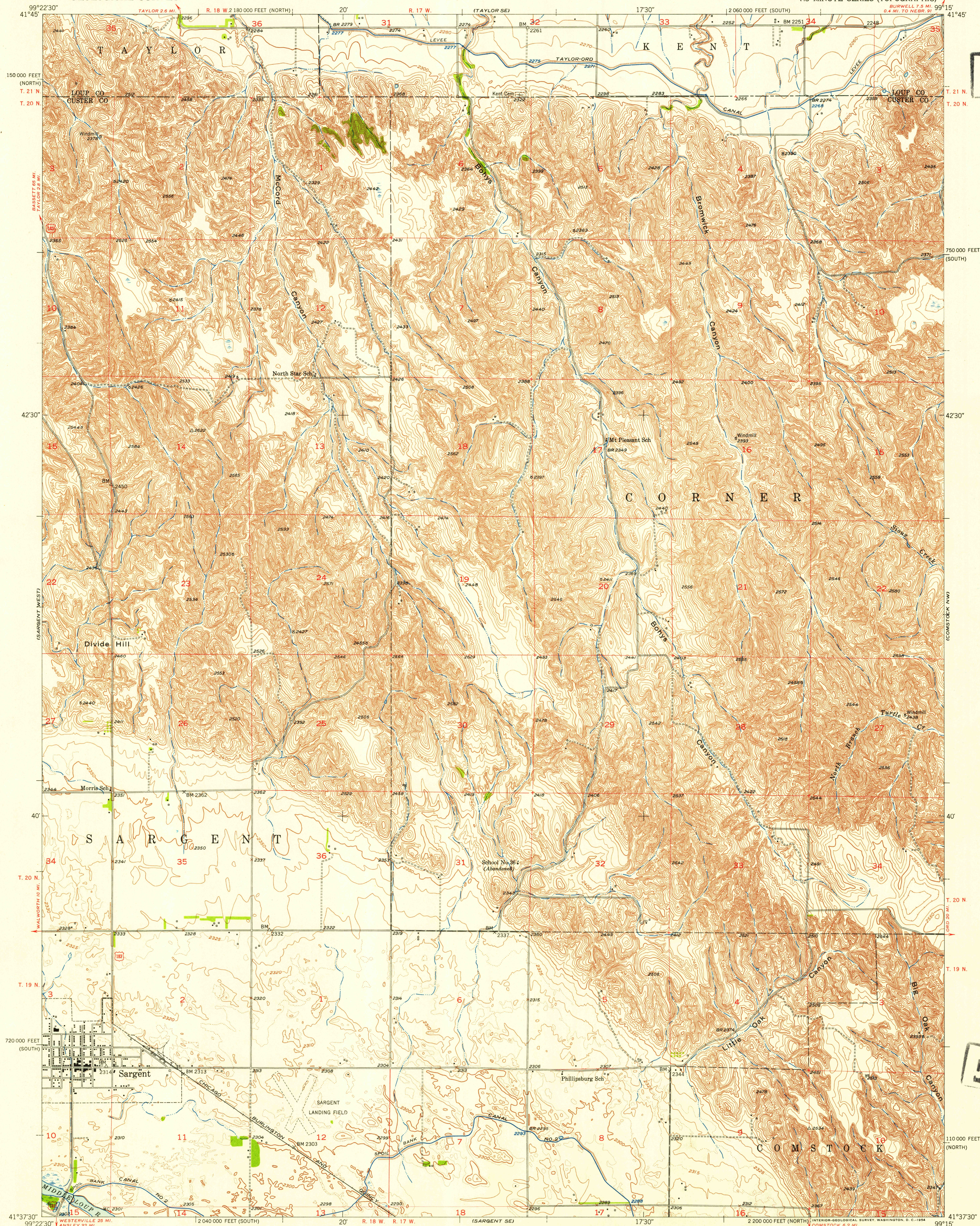

Polyconic projection. 1927 North American datum. 10,000-foot grids based on Nebraska coordinate system, north and south zones.

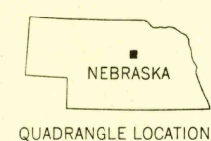
