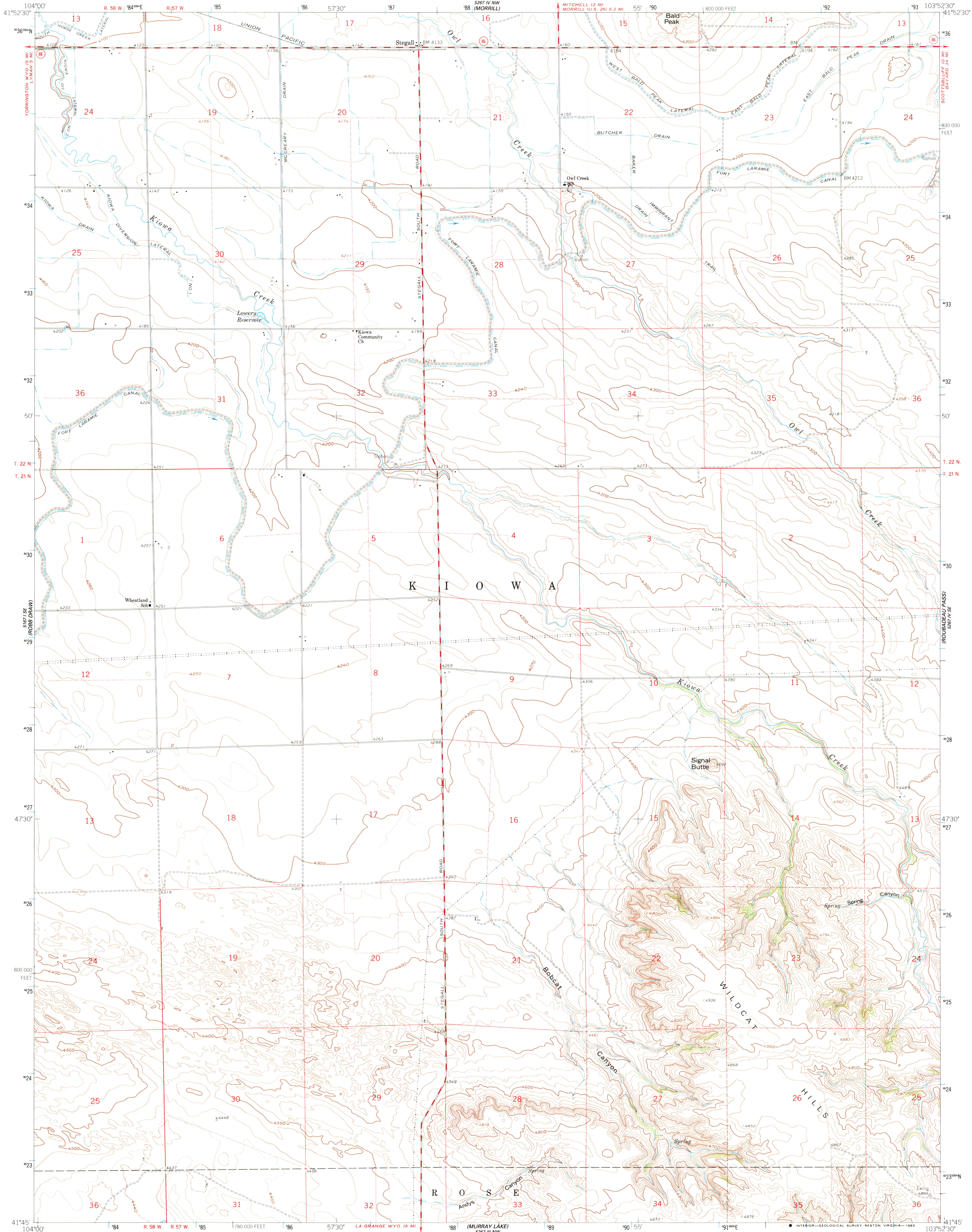
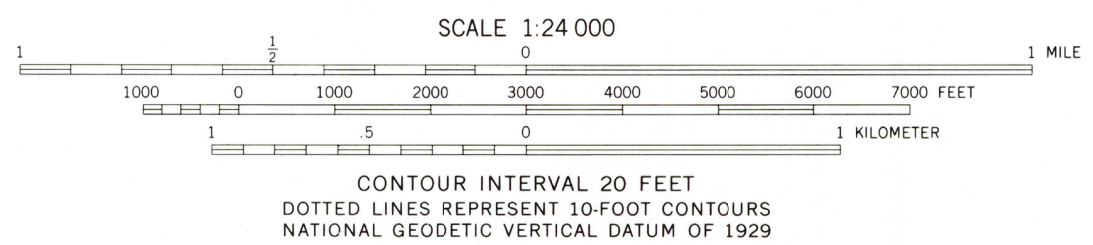
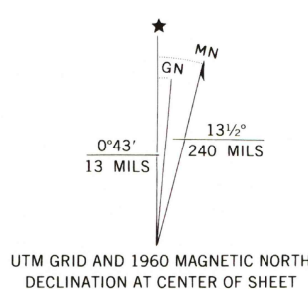


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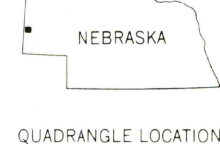

To place on the predicted North American Datum 1983 move the projection lines 6 meters north and 44 meters east as shown by dashed corner ticks
Area covered by dashed light-blue pattern is subject to controlled inundation
