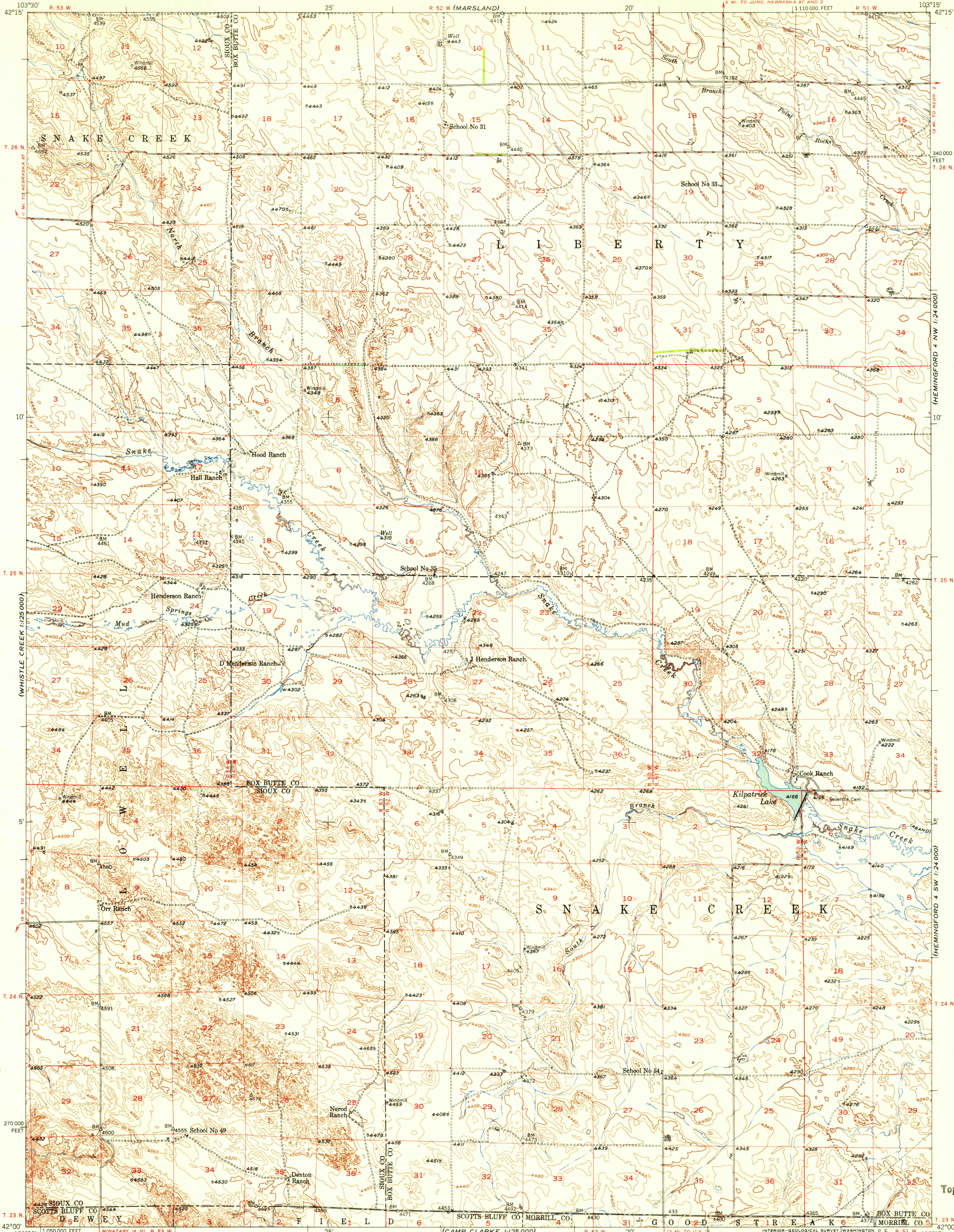

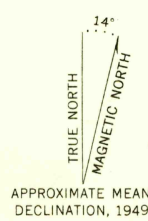
KILPATRICK LAKE QUADRANGLE
