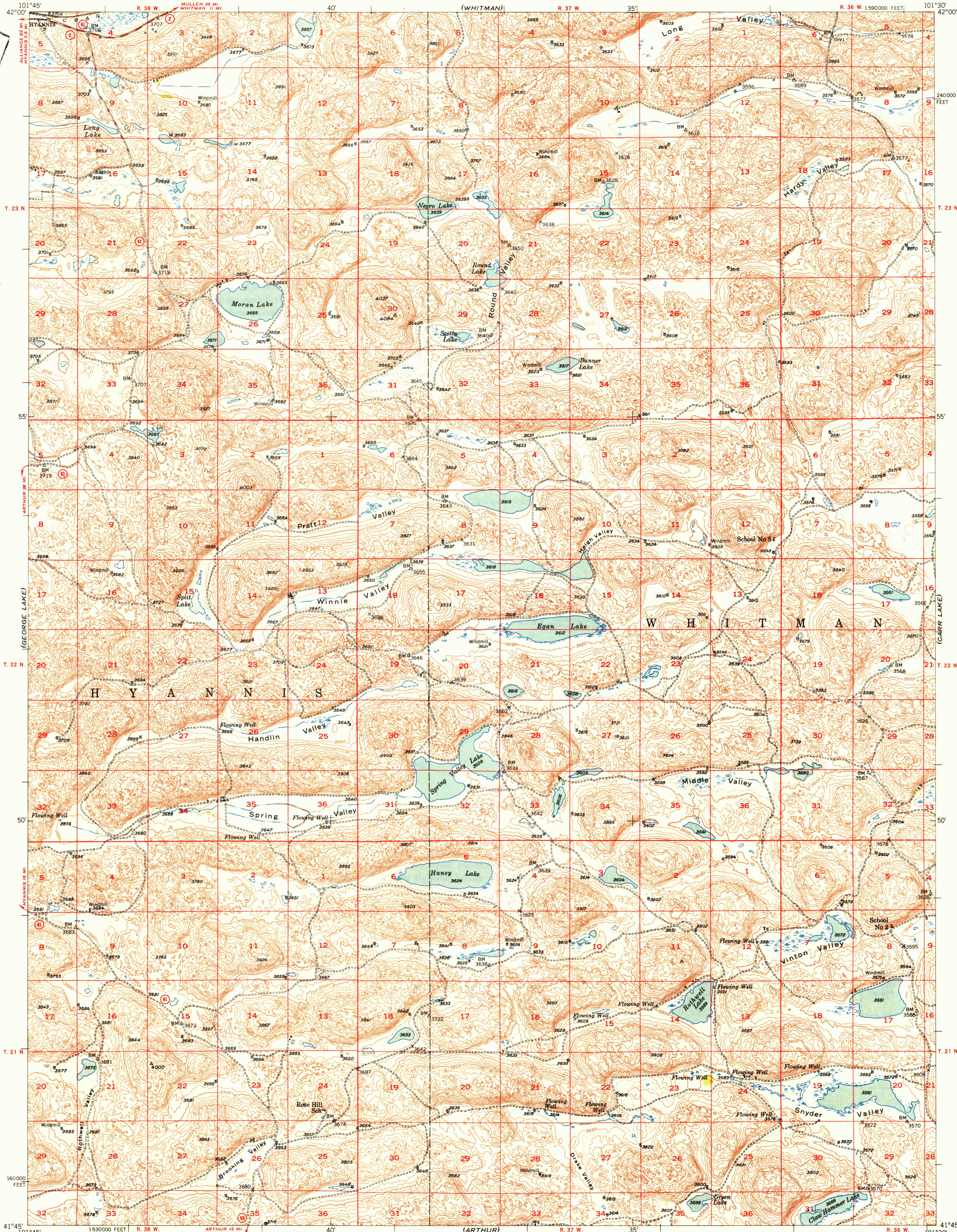

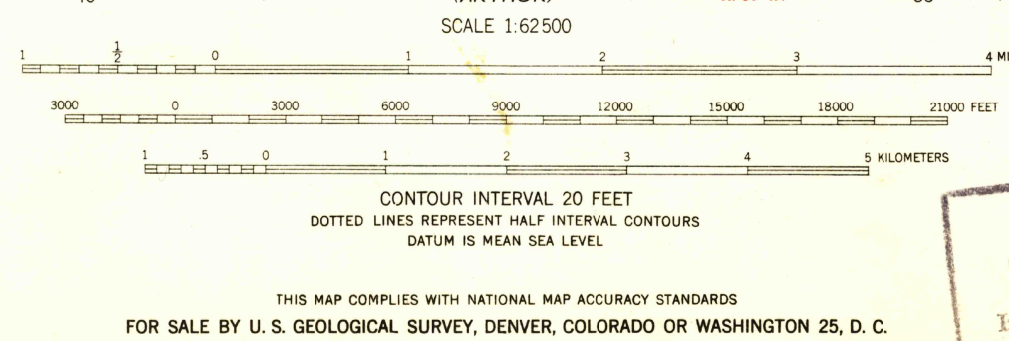
SPRING VALLEY QUADRANGLE
