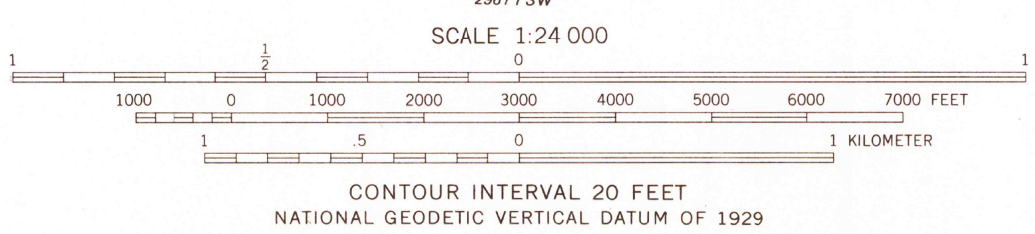
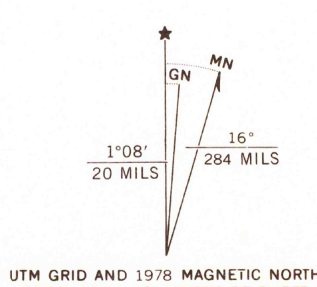


BADGER HOLE SPRING QUADRANGLE
