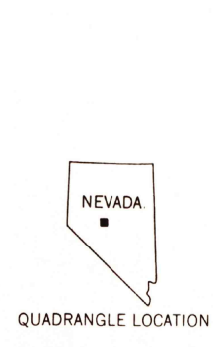
BURNT CABIN SUMMIT QUADRANGLE
