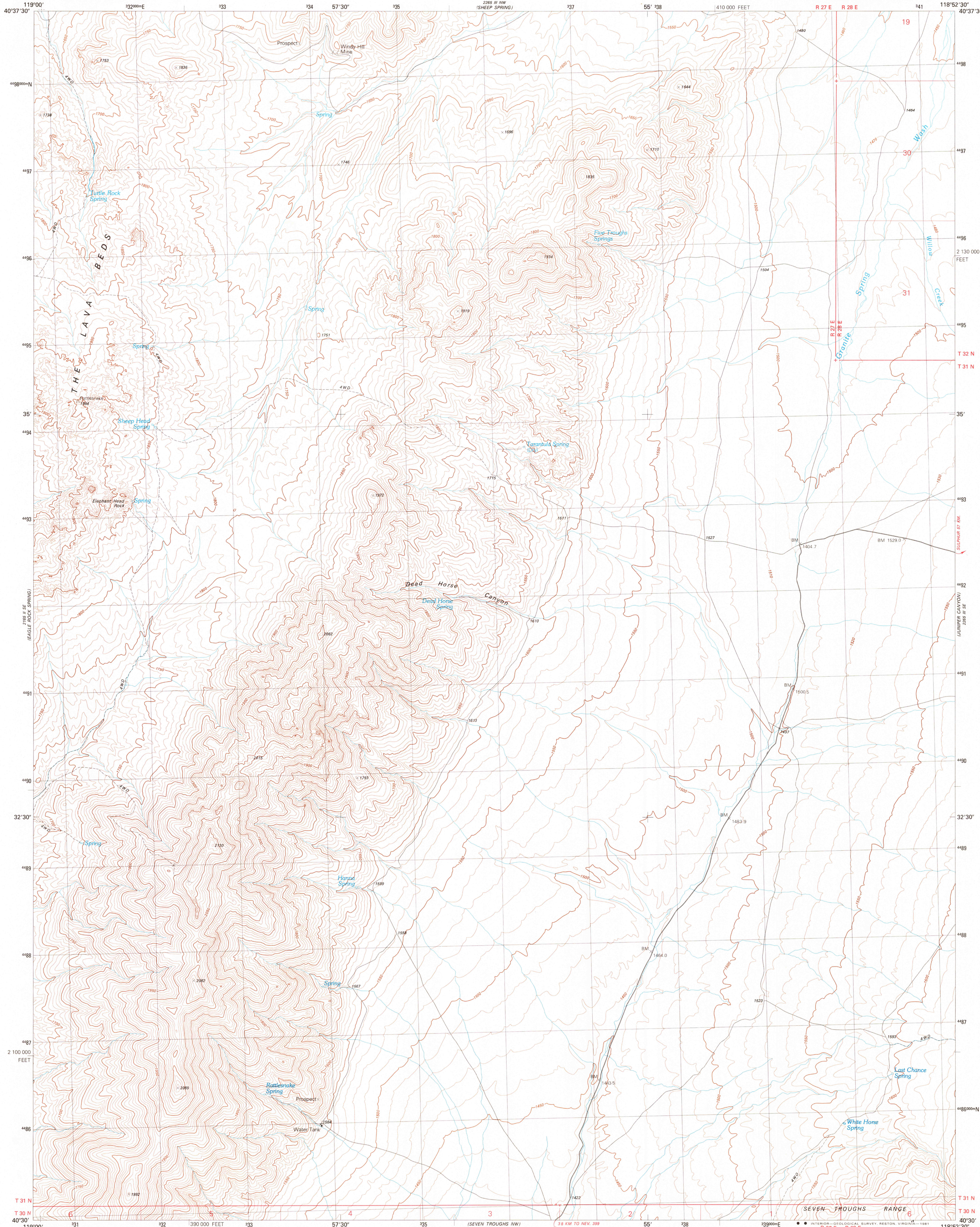

10,000-foot grid ticks based on Nevada coordinate

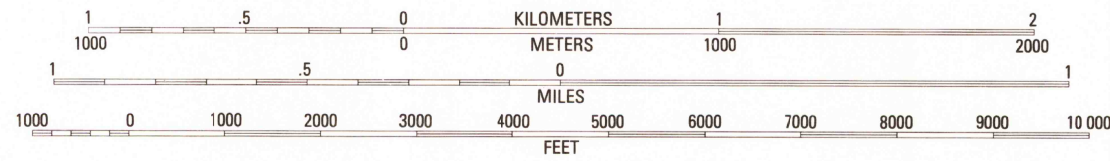
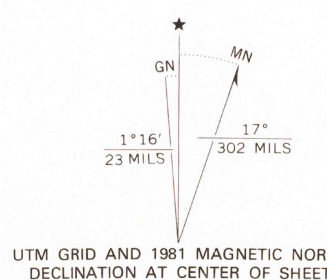

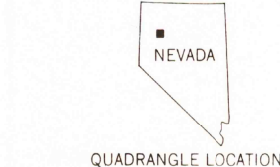
