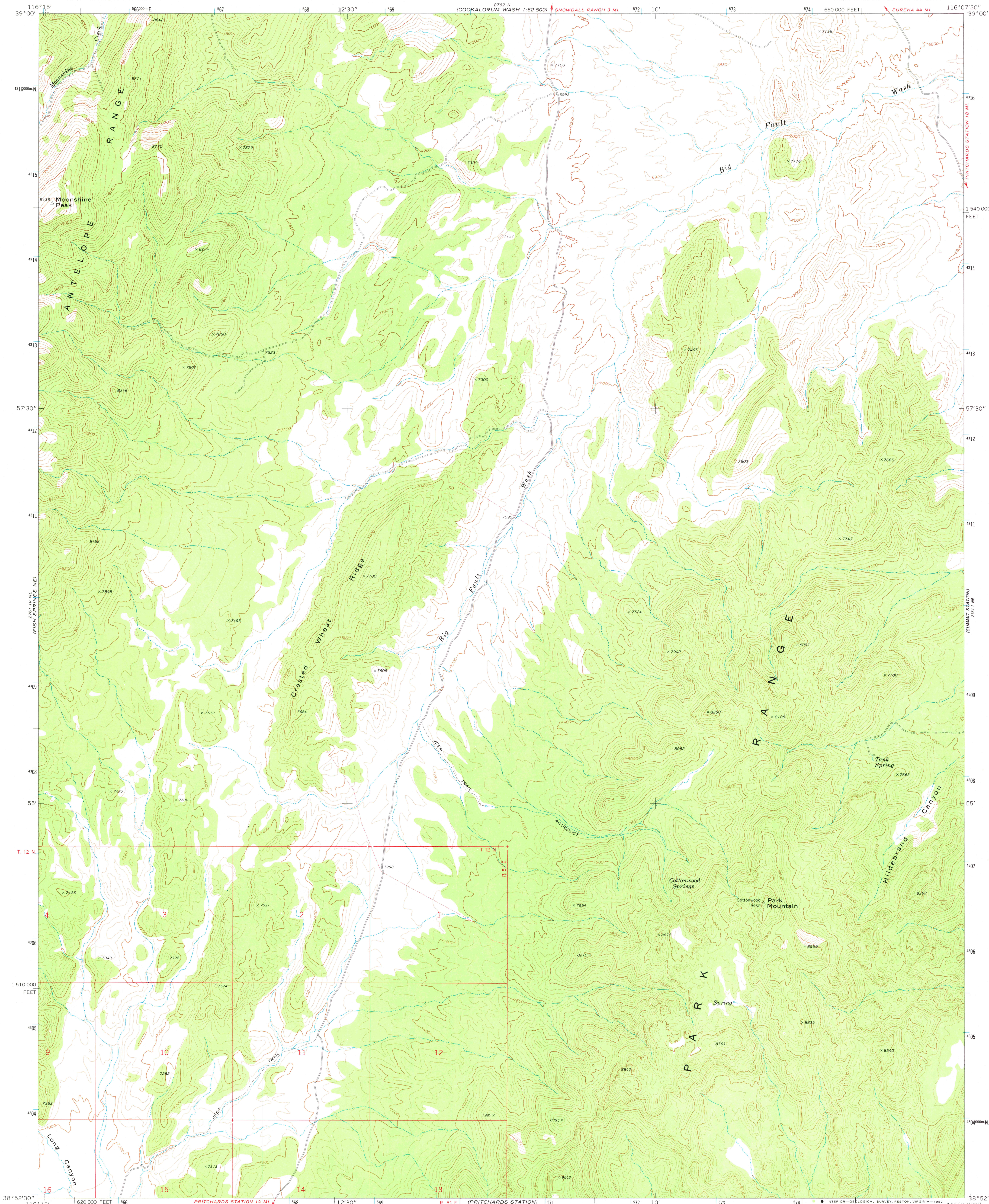

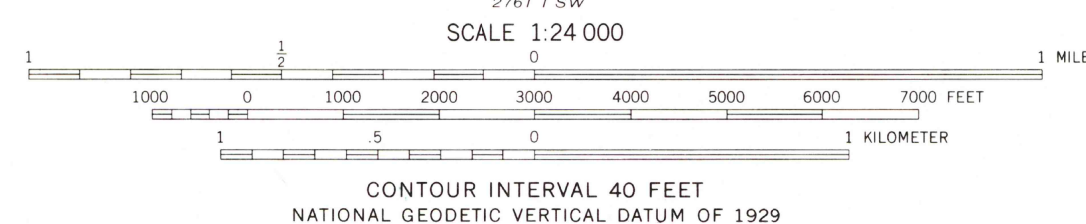
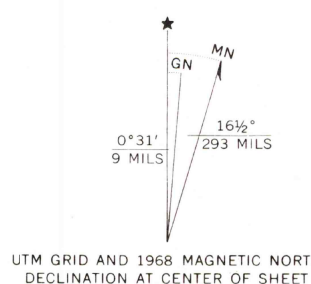

77 meters east as shown by dashed corner ticks

Fine red dashed lines indicate selected fence lines
Where omitted, land lines have not been established
