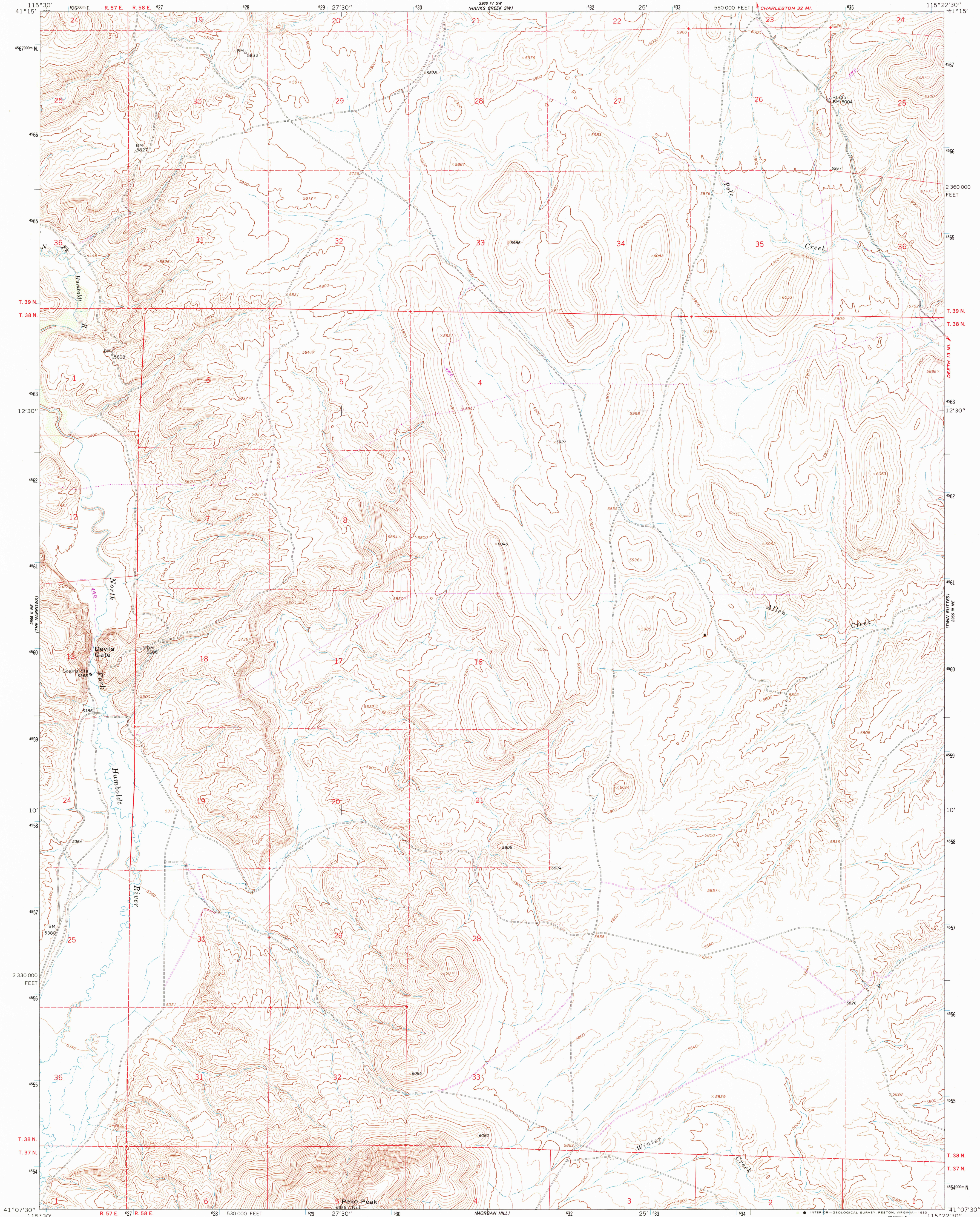

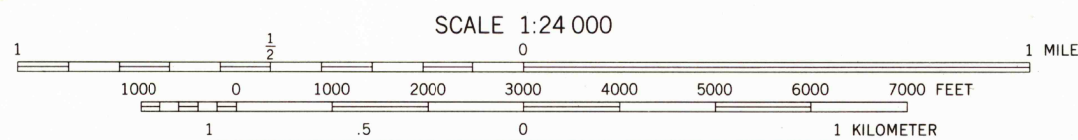
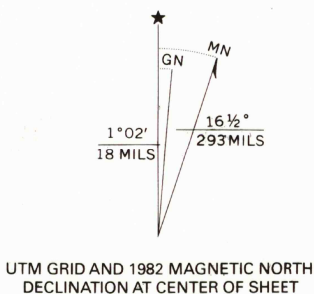

Polyconic projection. 1927 North American datum 10,000-foot grid based on Nevada coordinate system, east zone 1000-meter Universal Transverse Mercator grid ticks, zone 11, shown in blue

To place on the predicted North American Datum 1983, move the projection lines 13 meters north and 75 meters east as shown by dashed corner ticks

Fine red dashed lines indicate selected fence lines
Certain land lines are omitted because of insufficient data
