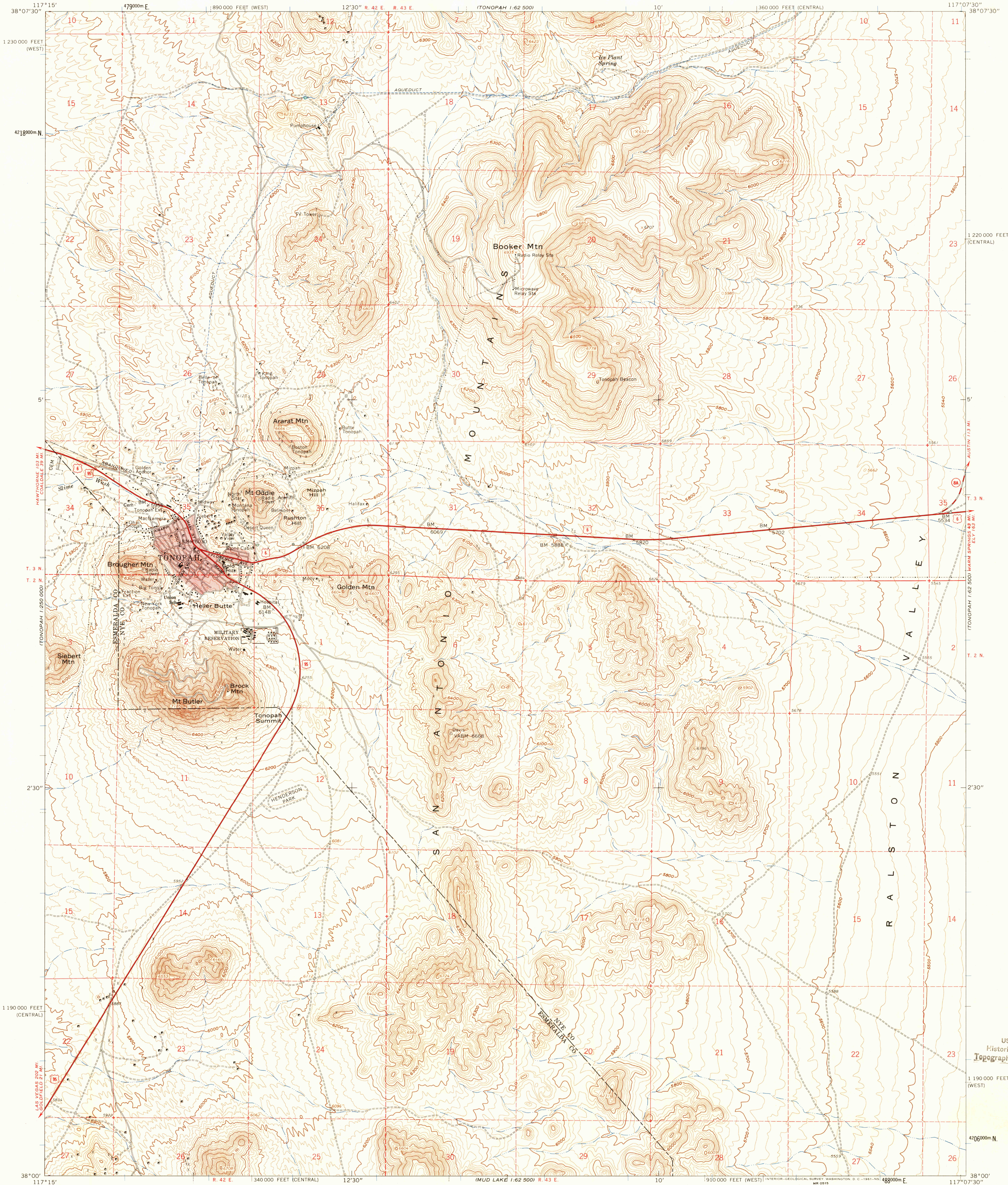

central and west zones

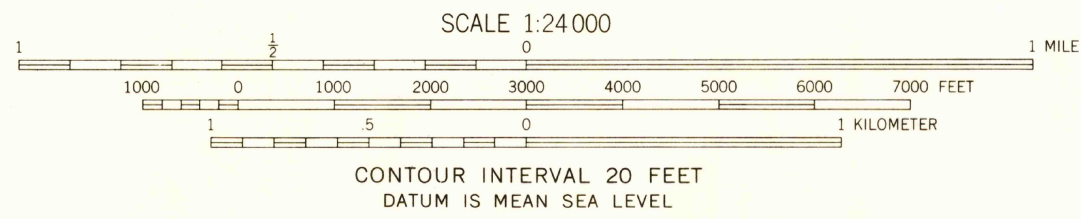
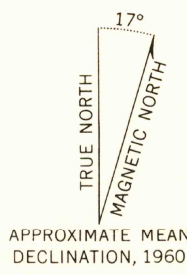
1000-meter Universal Transverse Mercator grid ticks,

landmark buildings are shown

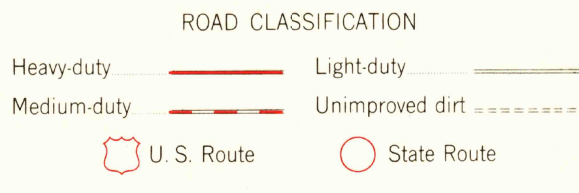
Dashed land lines indicate approximate locations
