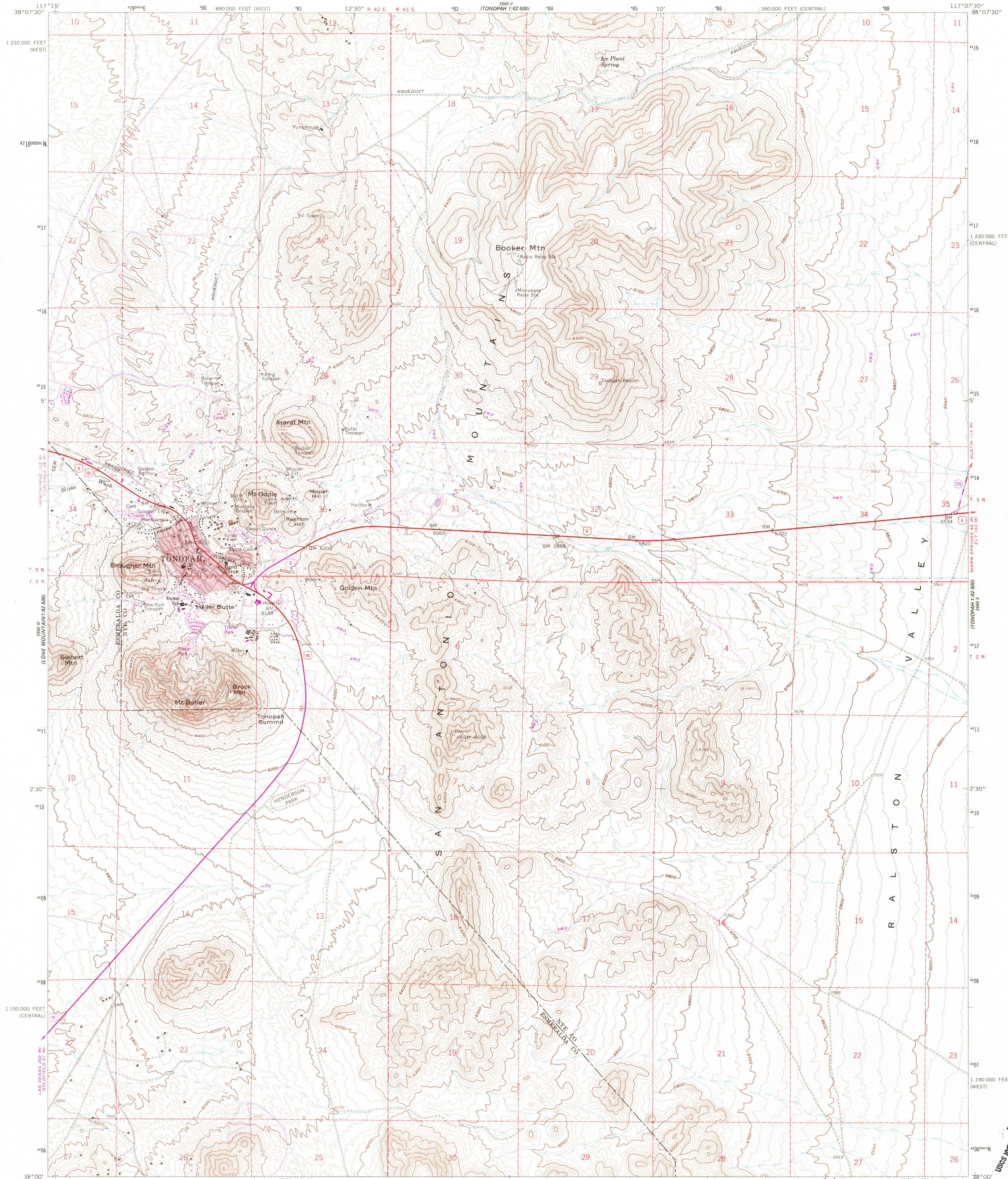

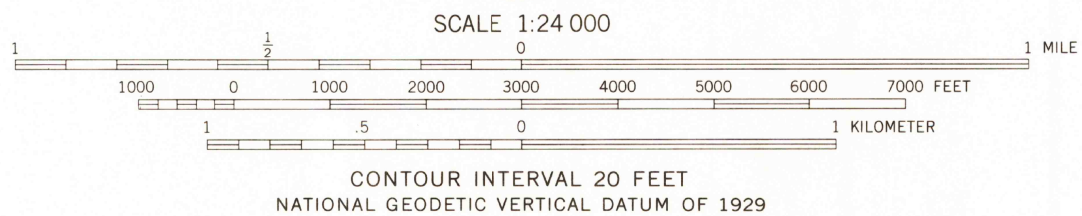
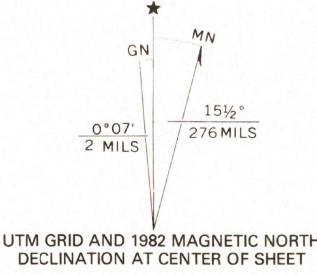
Polyconic projection. 1927 North American datum

80 meters east as shown by dashed corner ticks

Red tint indicates area in which only
landmark buildings are shown

Dashed land lines indicate approximate locations
