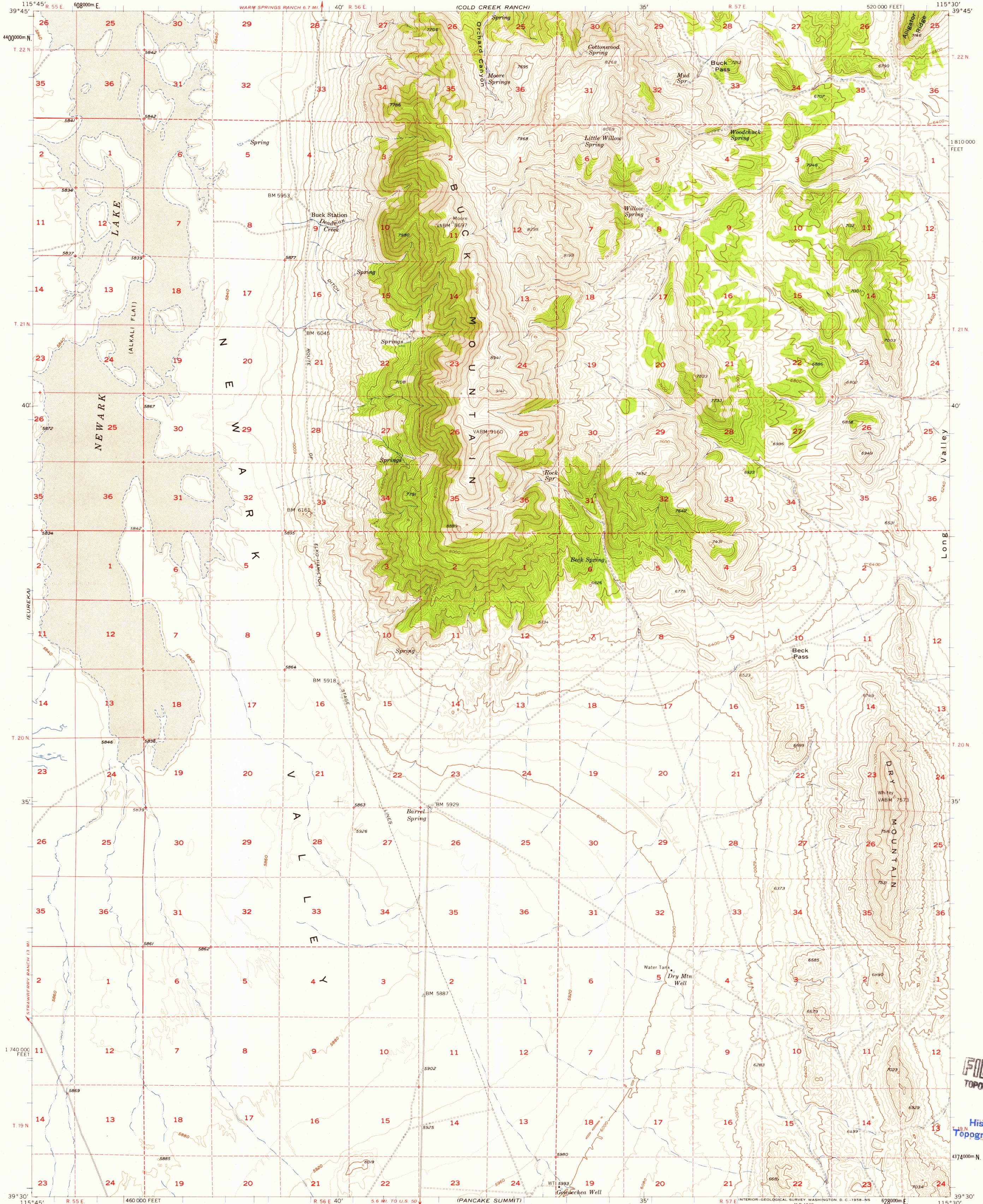

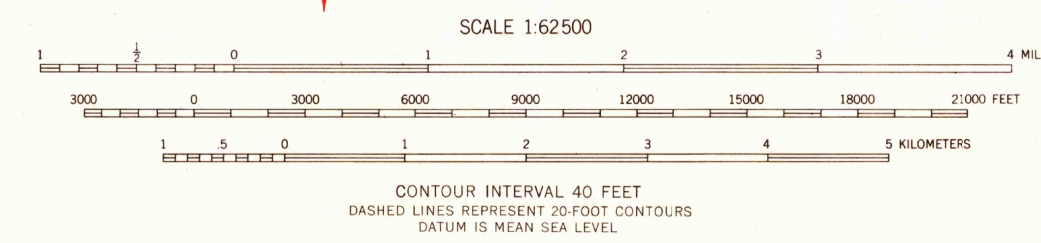
BUCK MOUNTAIN QUADRANGLE
