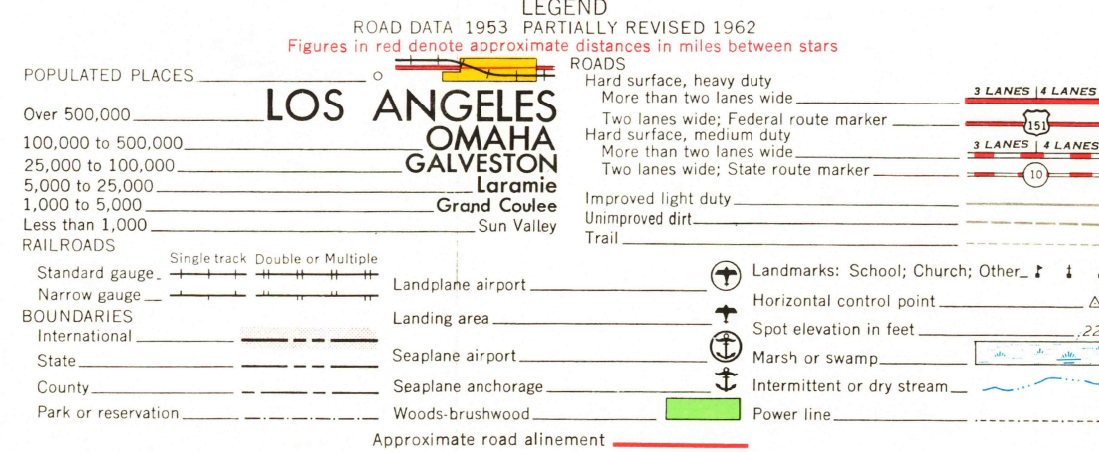

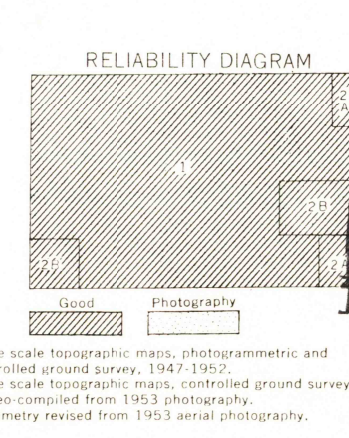
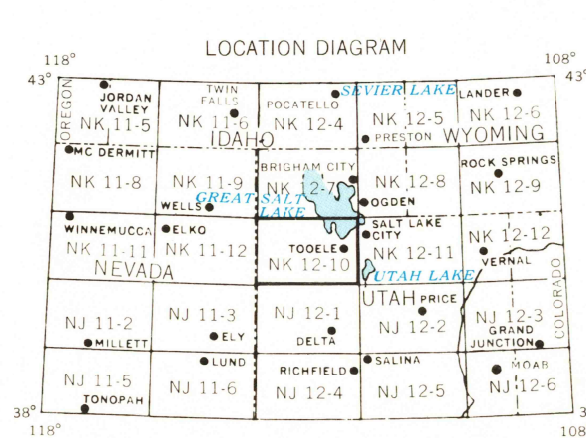
100,000-foot grids based on Utah coordinate system, central and north zones
