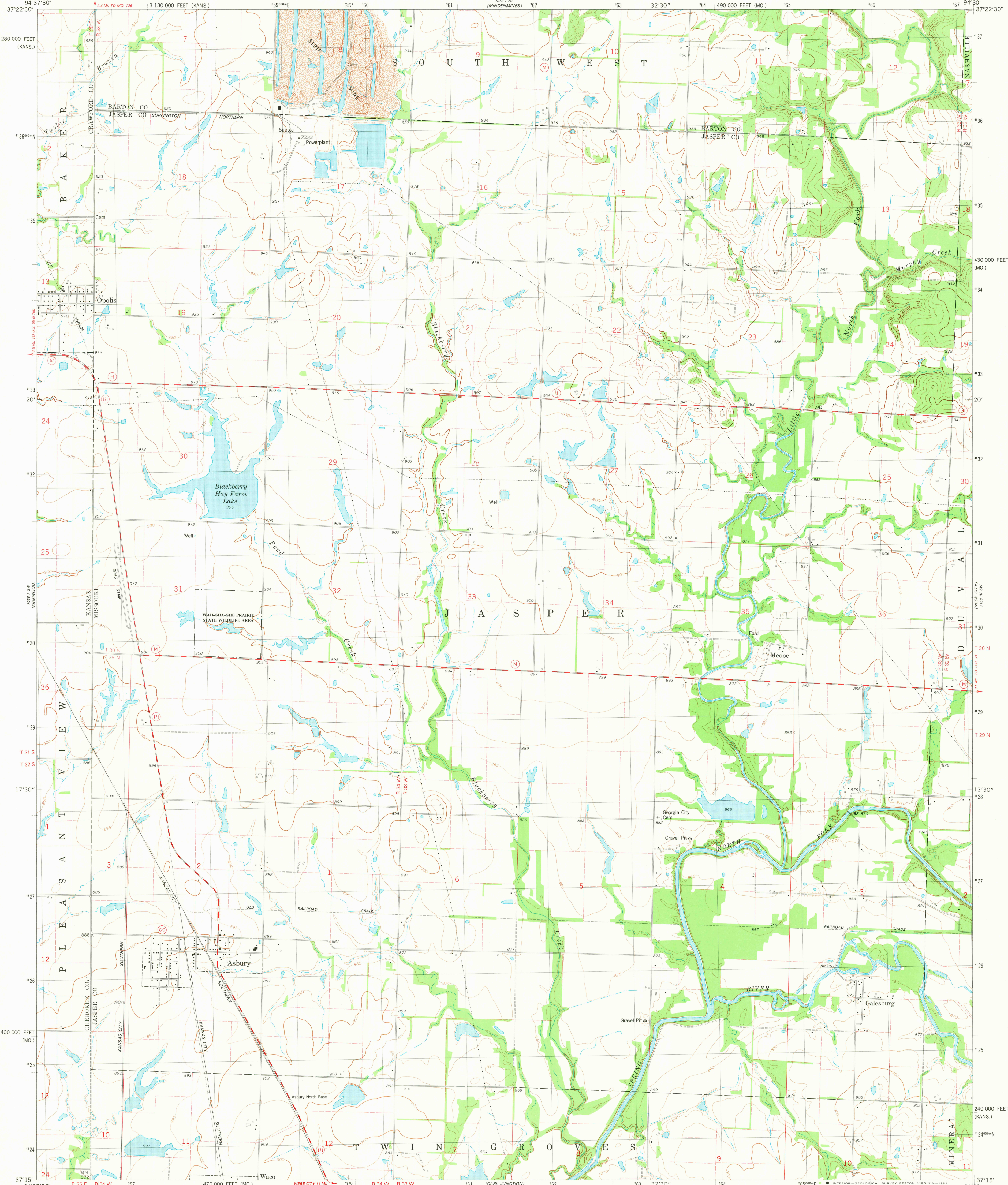

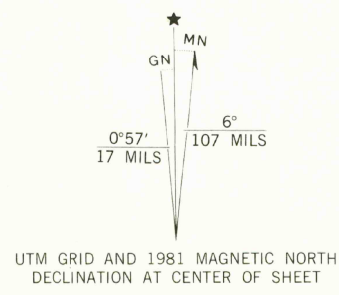
Projection: Missouri coordinate system, west zone (transverse Mercator)

To place on the predicted North American Datum 1983 move the projection lines 2 meters south and 20 meters east as shown by dashed corner ticks
