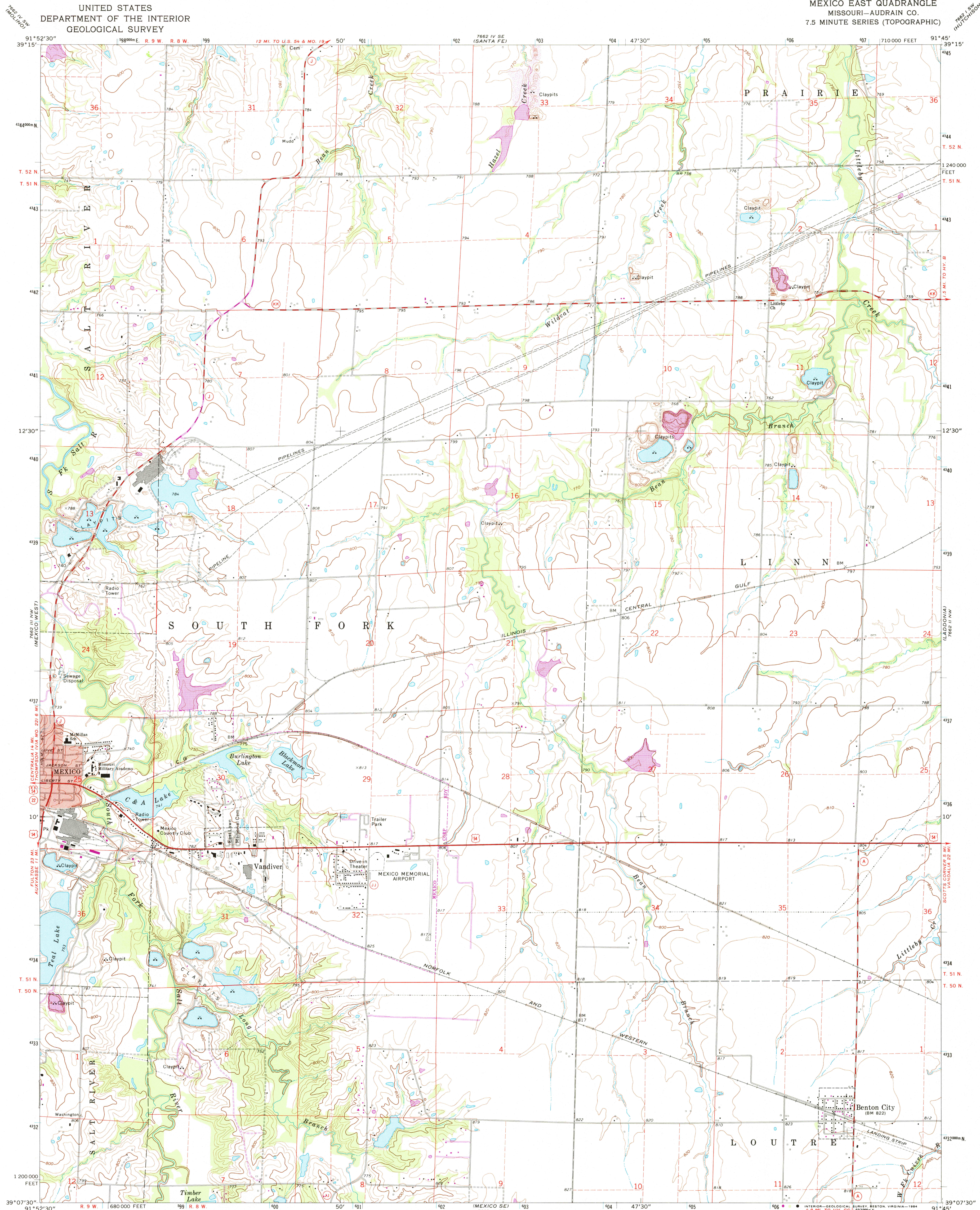

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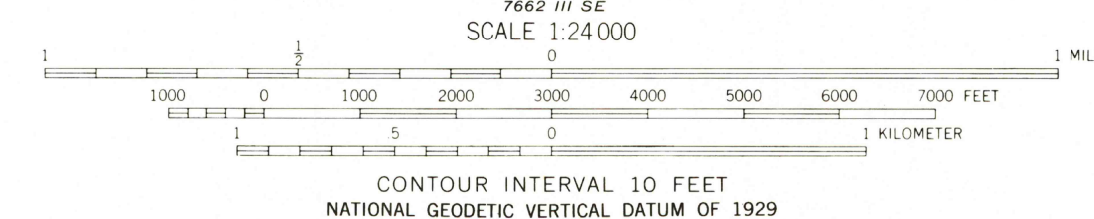
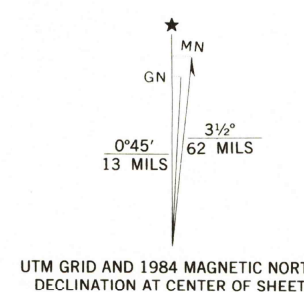
Topography by photogrammetric methods from aerial photographs taken 1971. Field checked 1972

To place on the predicted North American Datum 1983, move the projection lines 1 meter south and 13 meters east as shown by dashed corner ticks
