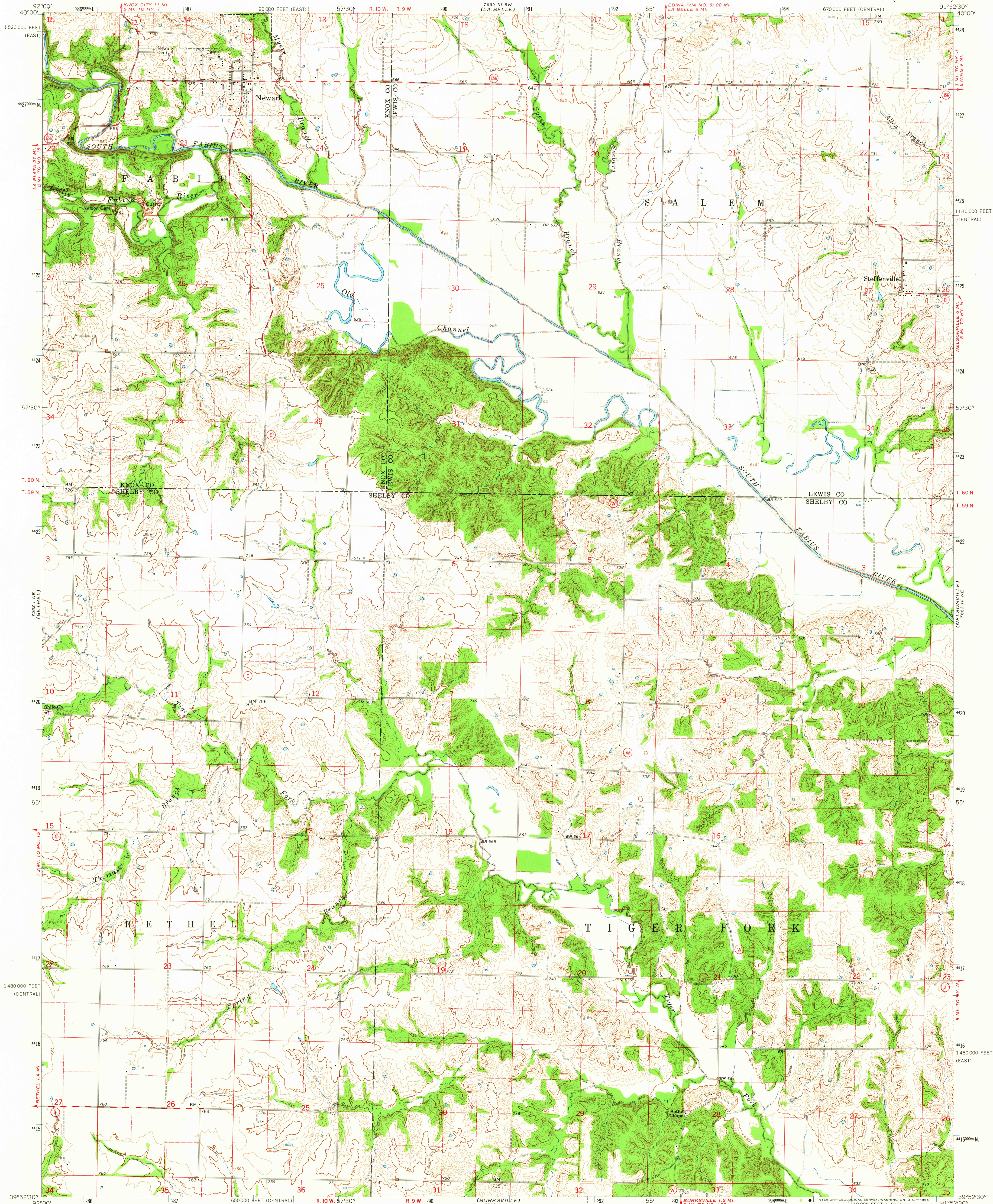




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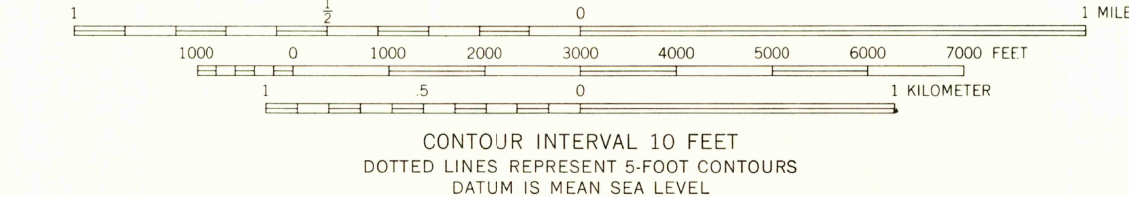
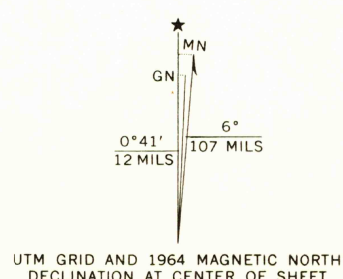
Topography by photogrammetric methods from aerial photographs taken 1960 and planetable surveys 1964

1000-meter Universal Transverse Mercator grid ticks, zone 15, shown in blue

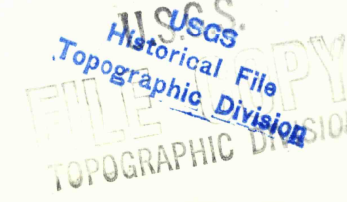
Fine red dashed lines indicate selected fence and field lines where generally visible on aerial photographs. This information is unchecked
