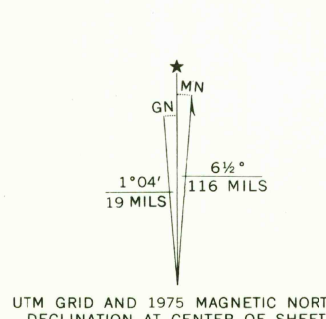

Red tint indicates area in which only landmark buildings are shown
To place on the predicted North American Datum 1983
move the projection lines 3 meters north and
20 meters east as shown by dashed corner ticks
