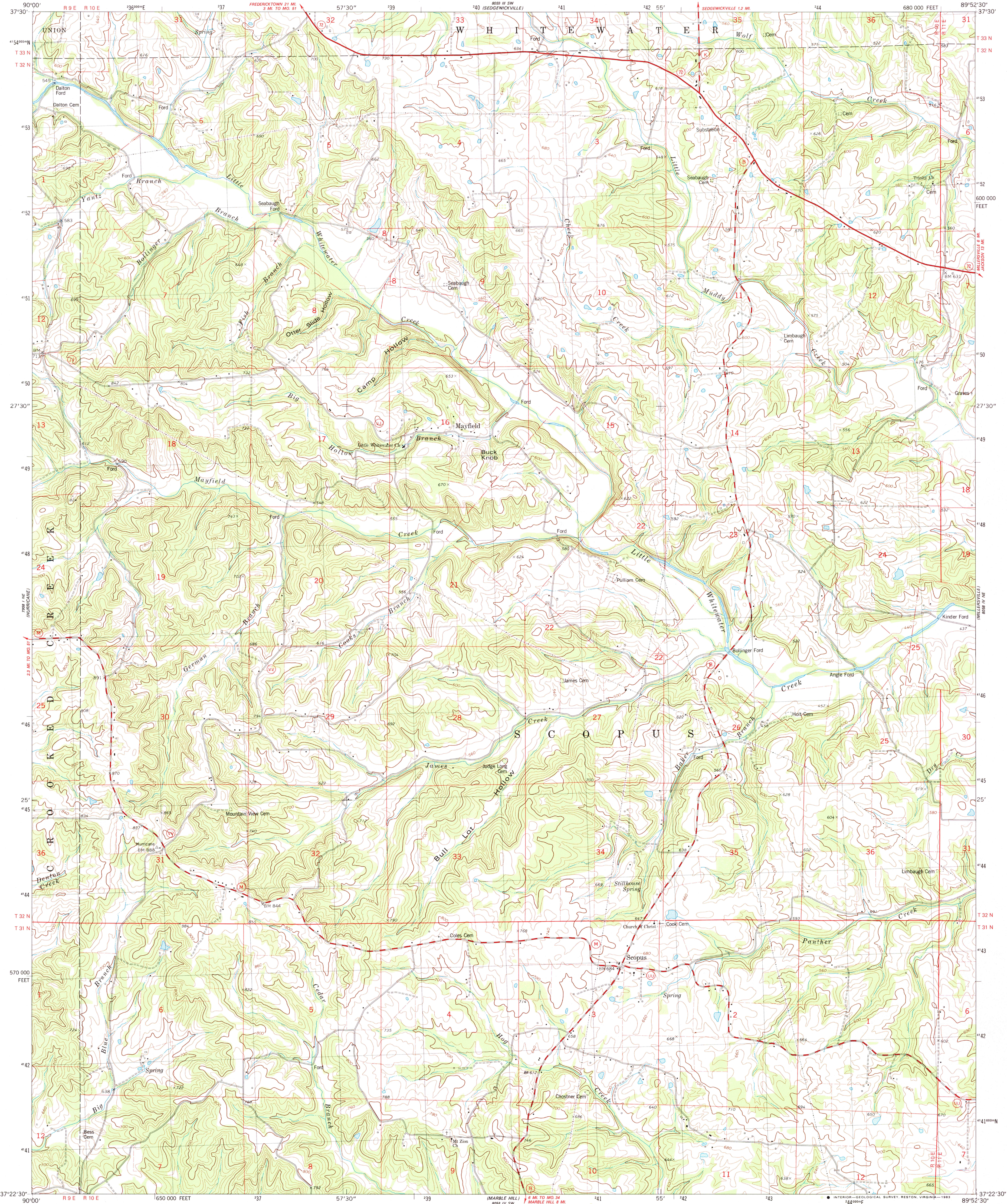

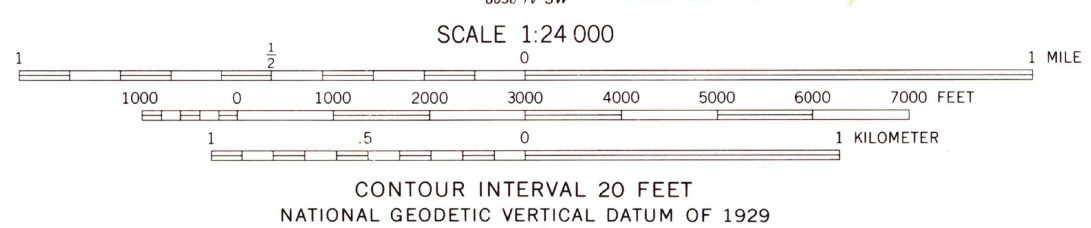
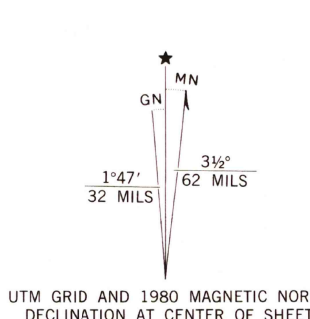
Projection and 10,000-foot grid ticks: Missouri coordinate system, east zone (transverse Mercator)

To place on the predicted North American Datum 1983 move the projection lines 3 meters south and 8 meters east as shown by dashed corner ticks
