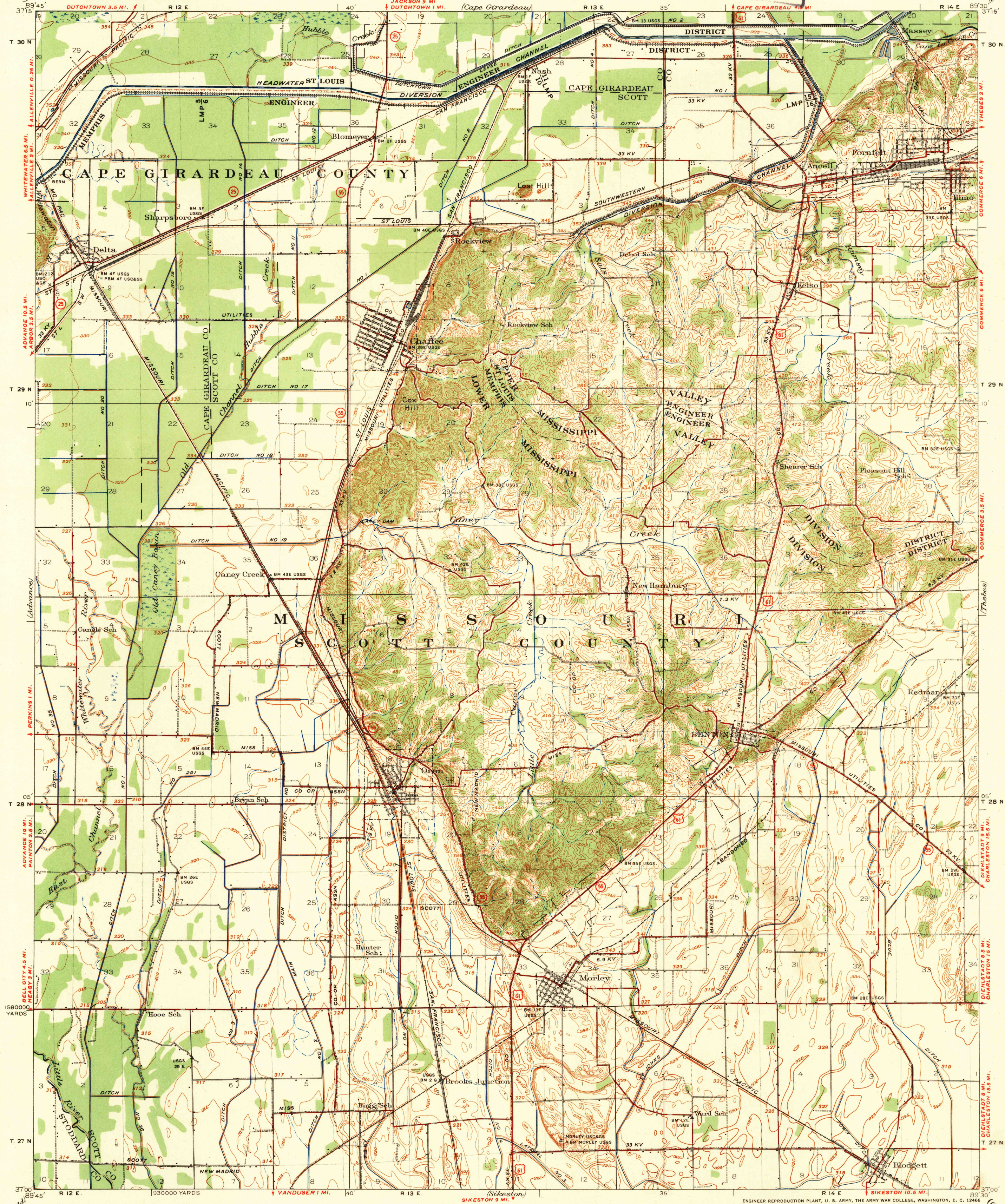
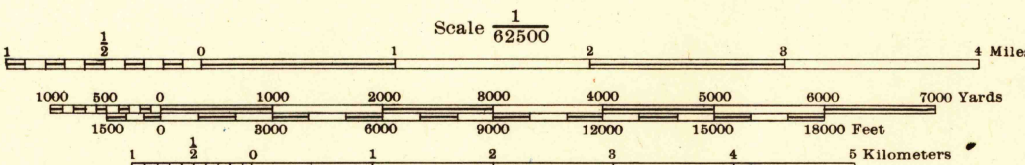




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Descriptions, elevations and geodetic positions of bench marks may be obtained from Memphis Engineer District, Memphis, Tenn.
