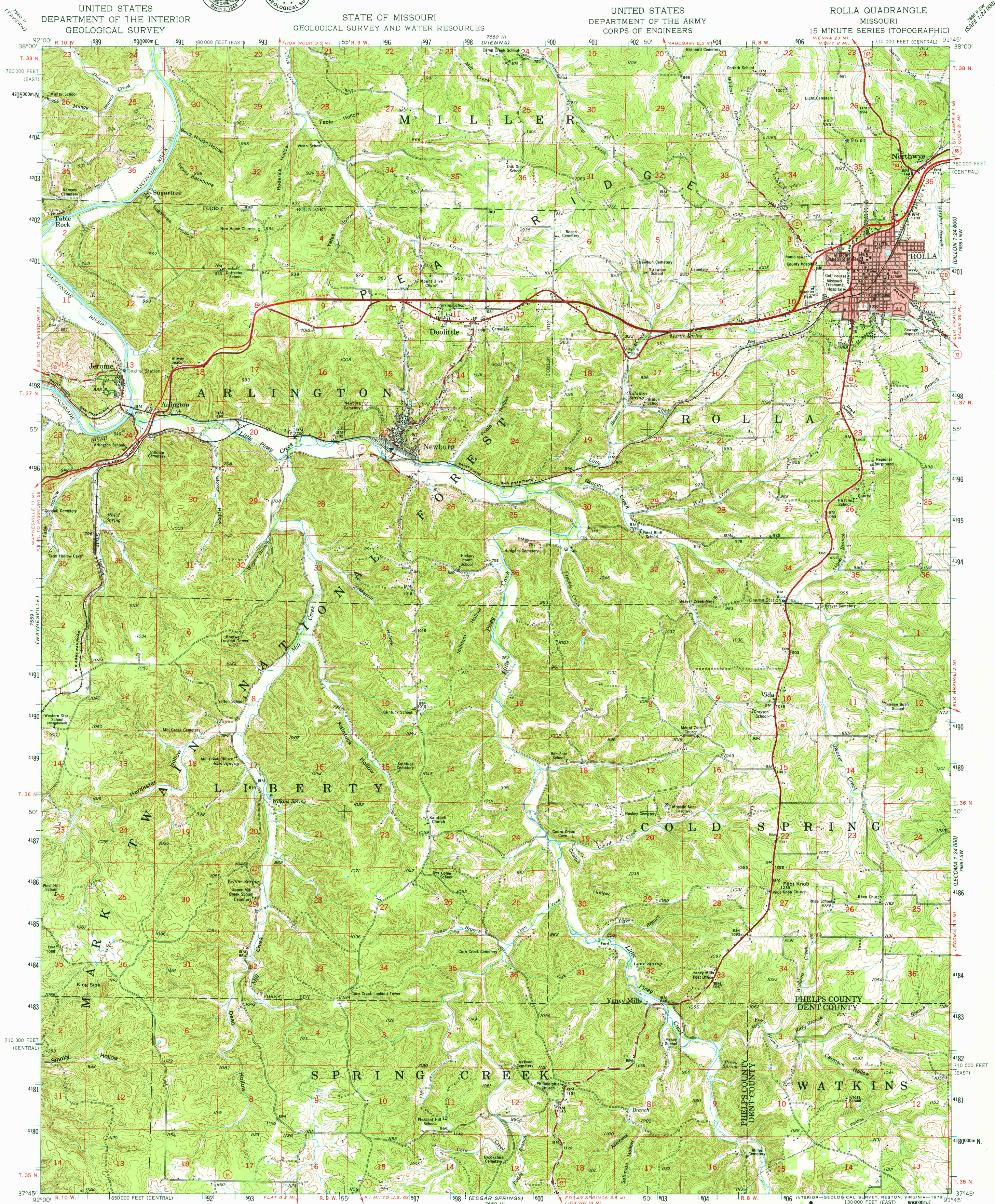

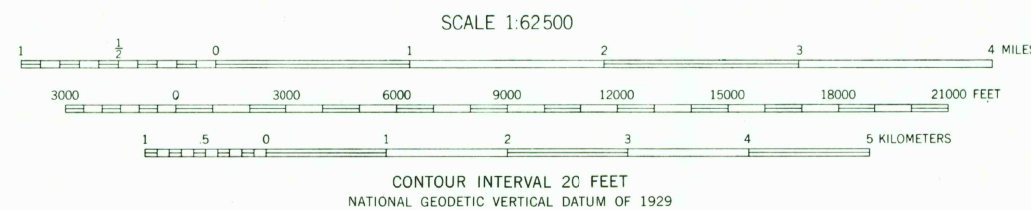
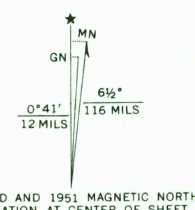

Polyconic projection. 1927 North American datum. 10,000-foot grids based on Missouri coordinate system central and east zones. 1000-meter Universal Transverse Mercator grid ticks, zone 15, shown in blue.
