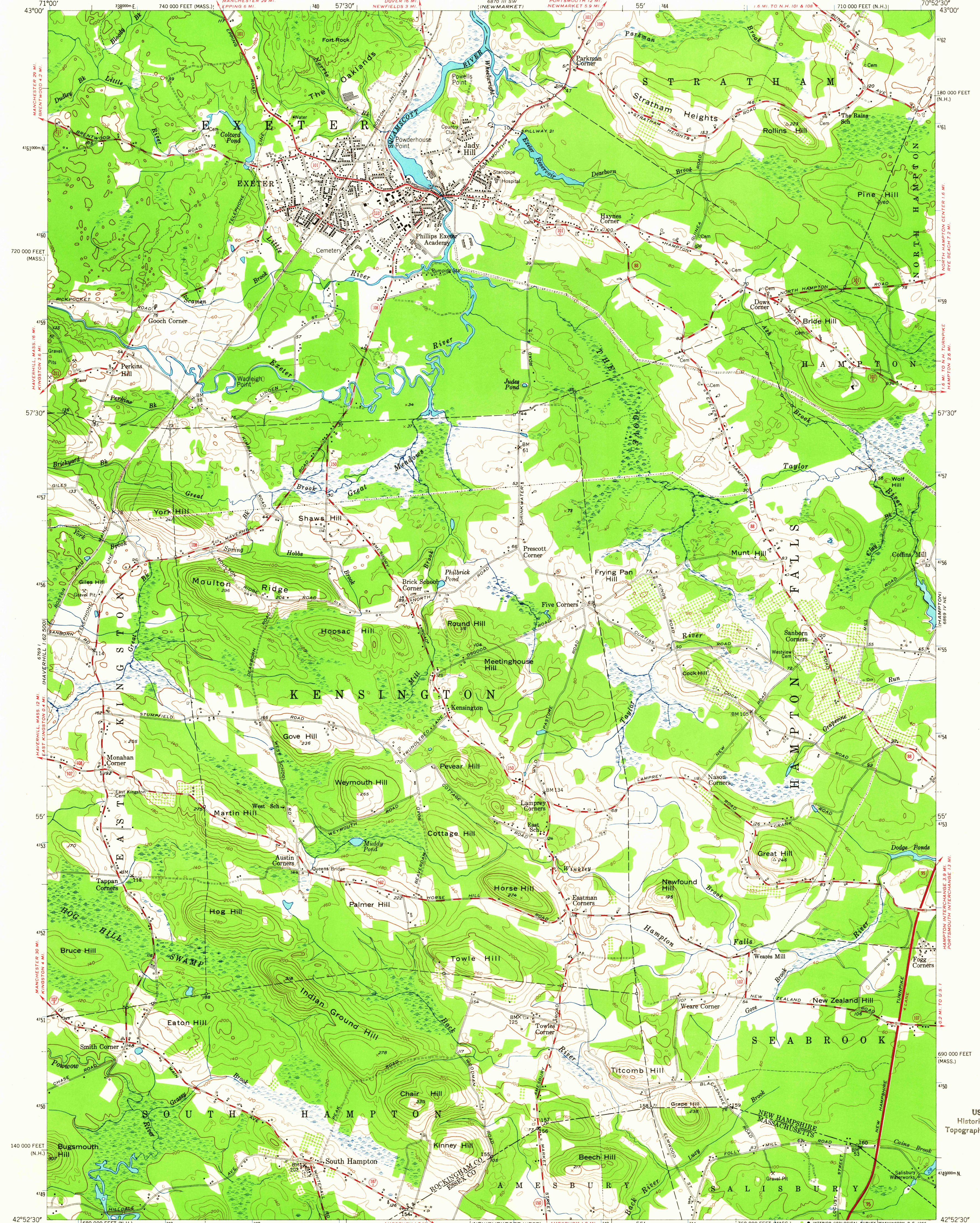

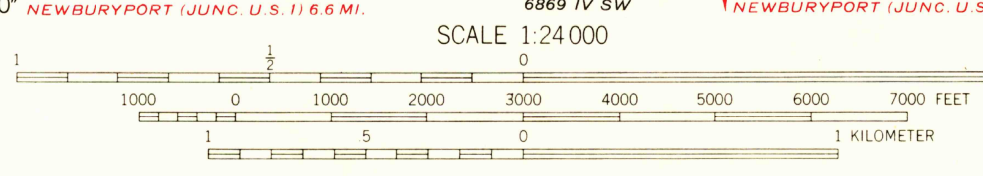
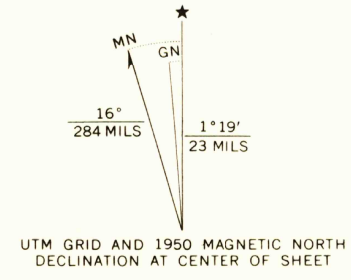
EXETER QUADRANGLE
