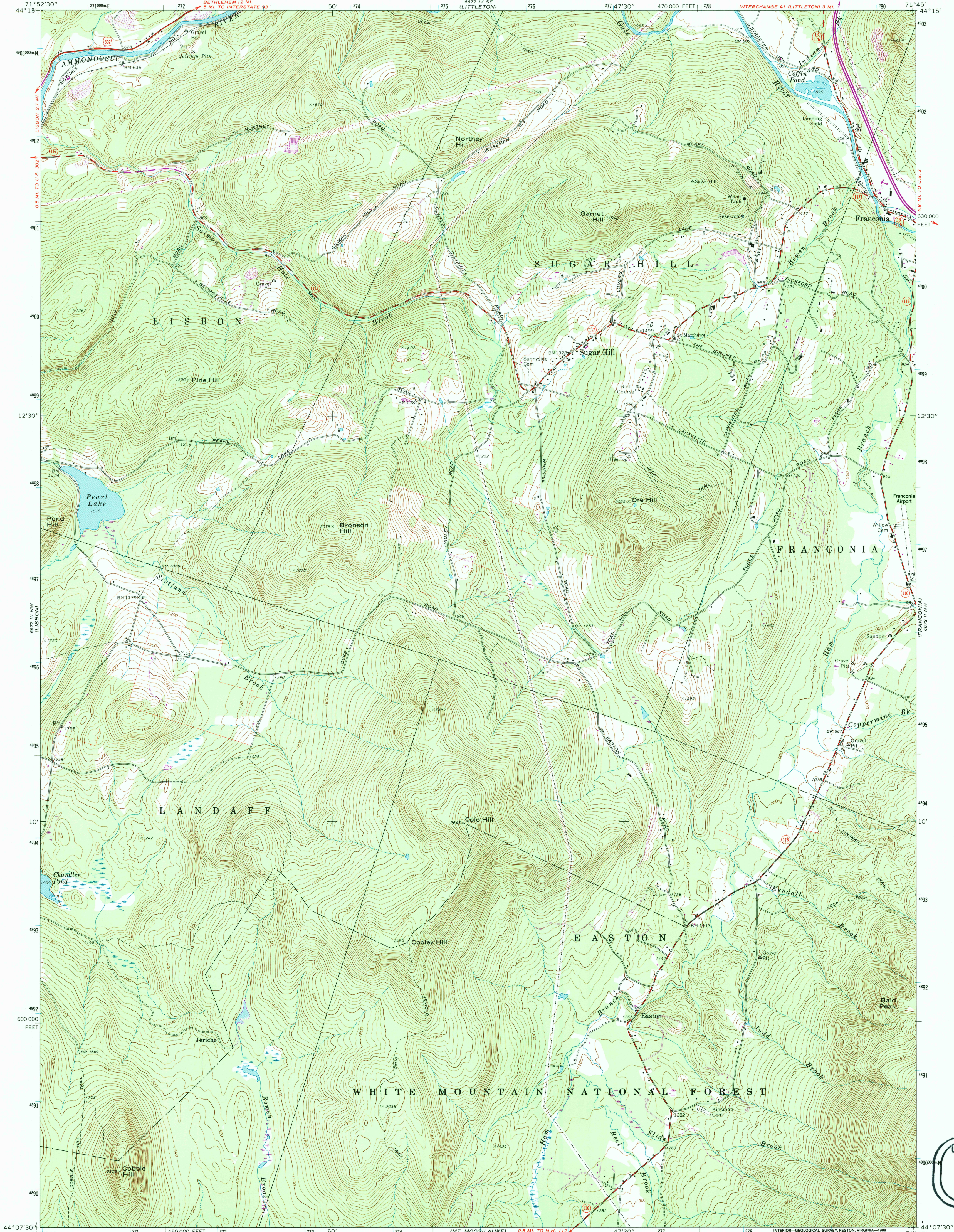

10,000-foot grid based on New Hampshire coordinate system

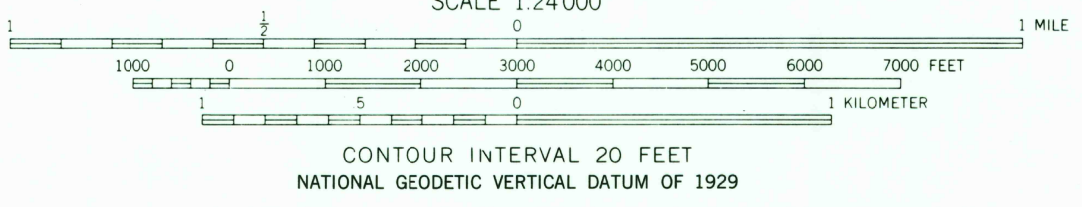
1000-meter Universal Transverse Mercator grid ticks, zone 19, shown in blue
