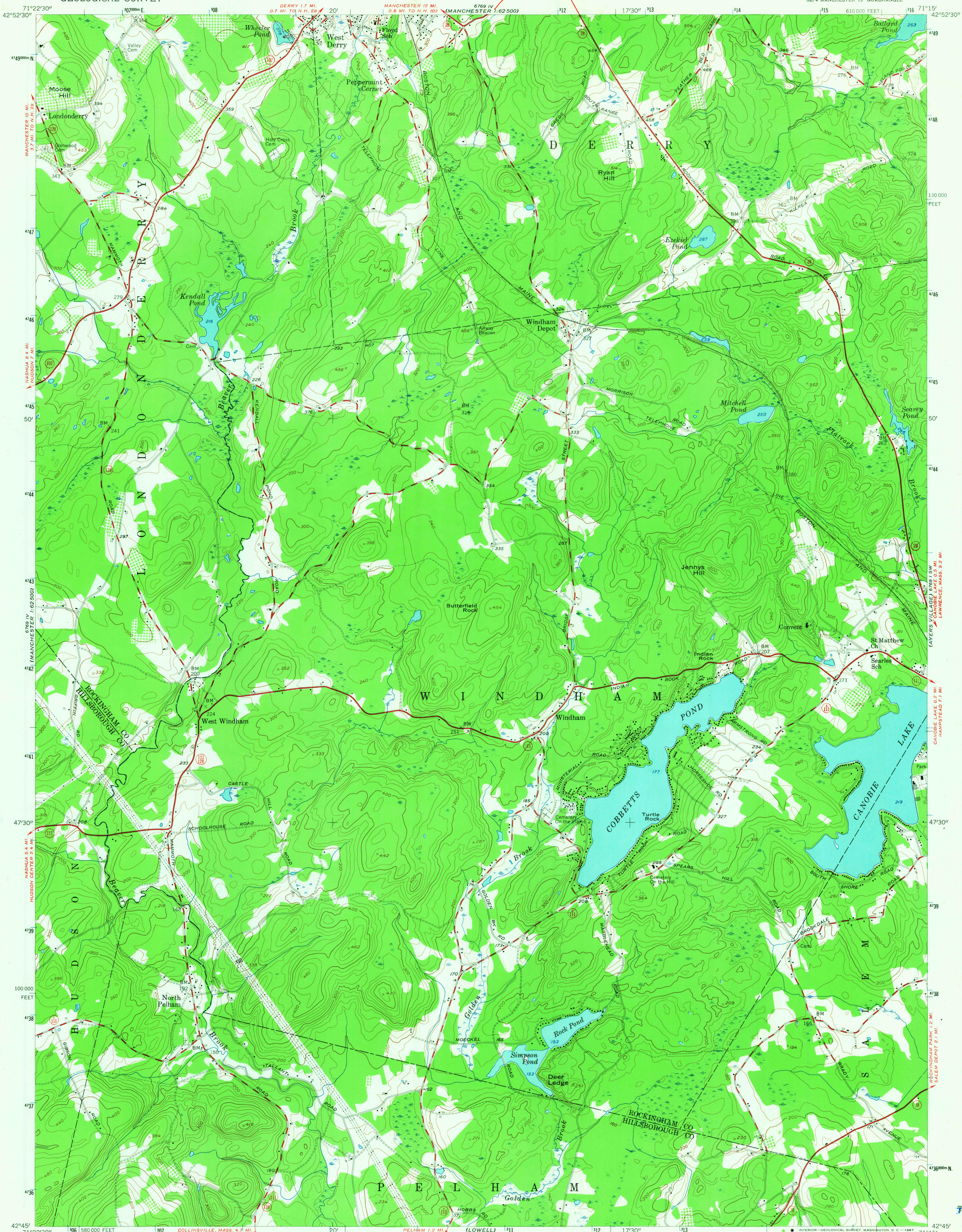

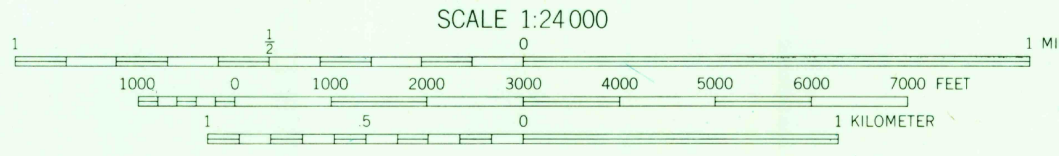
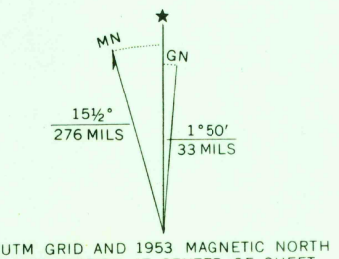

10,000-foot grid based on New Hampshire coordinate system

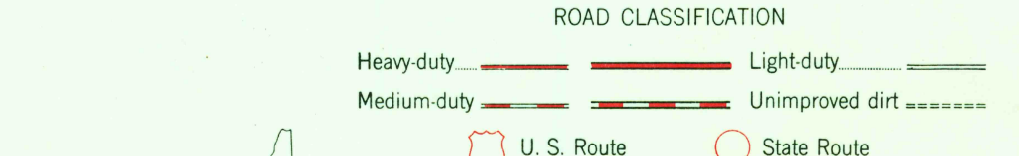
Unchecked elevations are shown in brown
