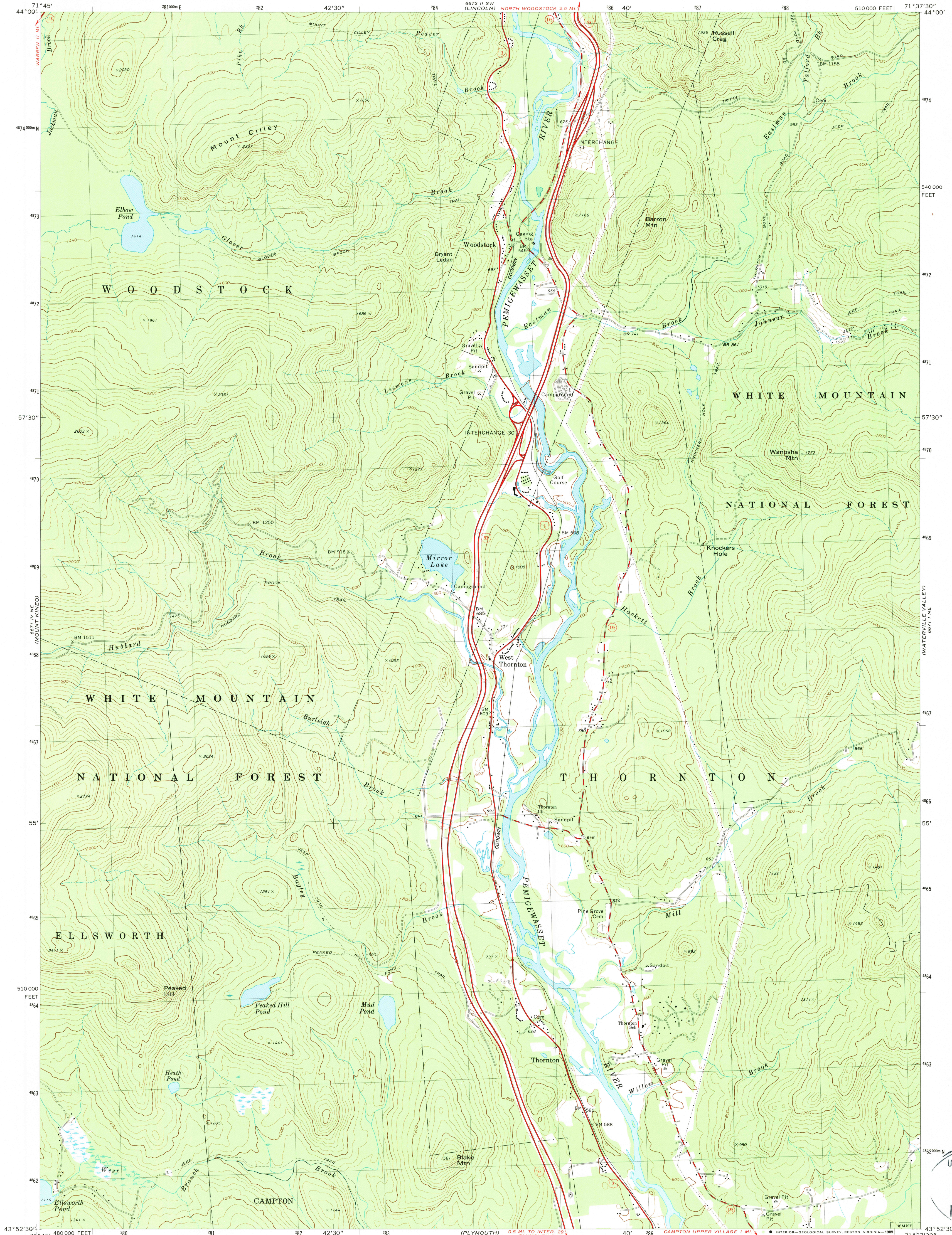

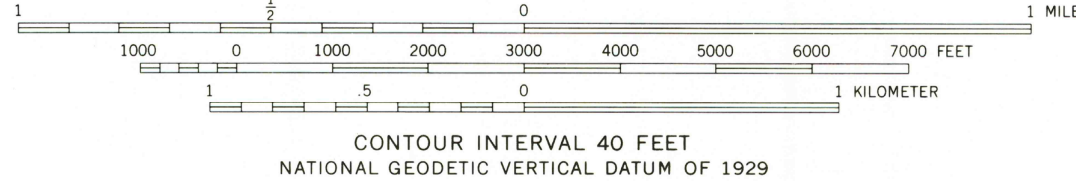
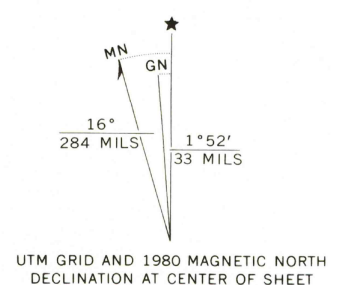
WOODSTOCK QUADRANGLE
