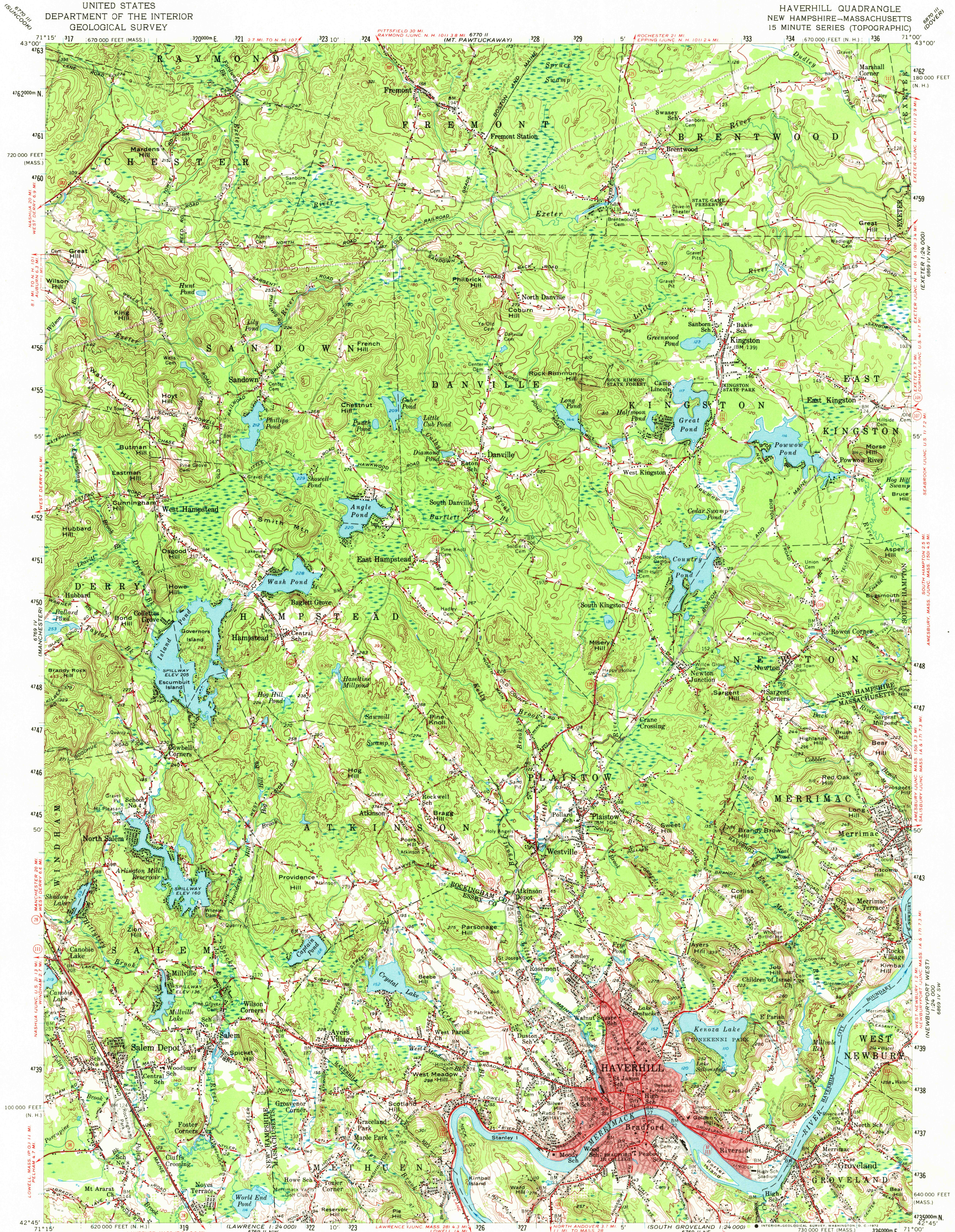

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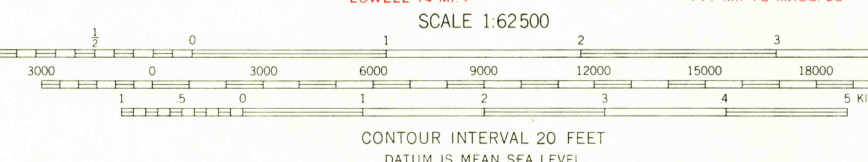
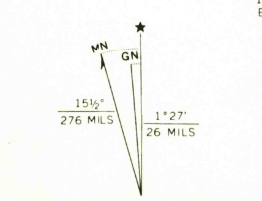
Topography on north half by planetable surveys

7.5 minute quadrangles, surveyed 1952 and 1955

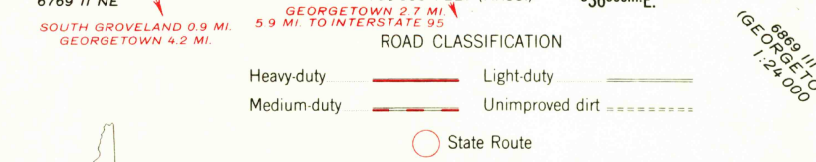
Polyconic projection. 1927 North American datum
