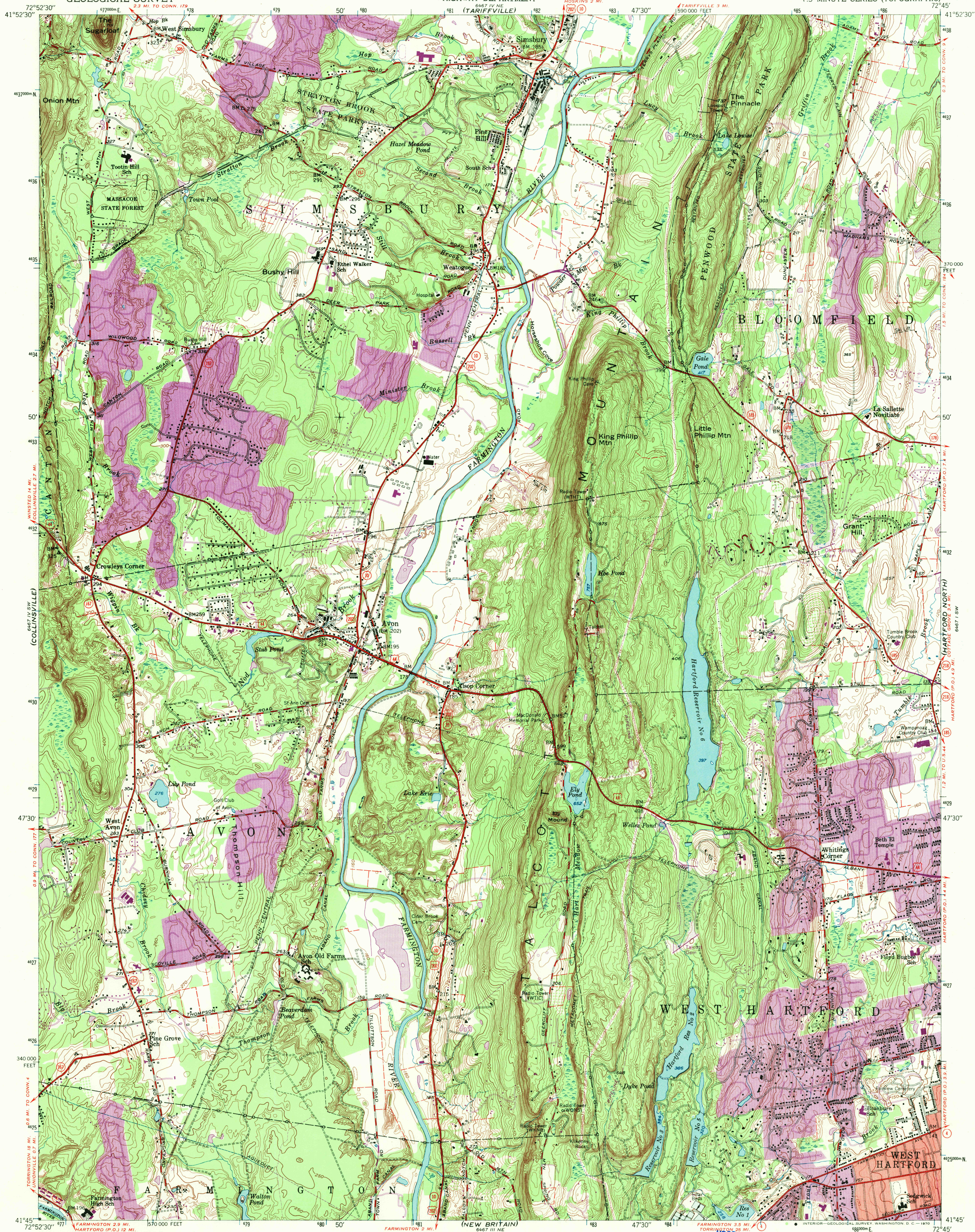




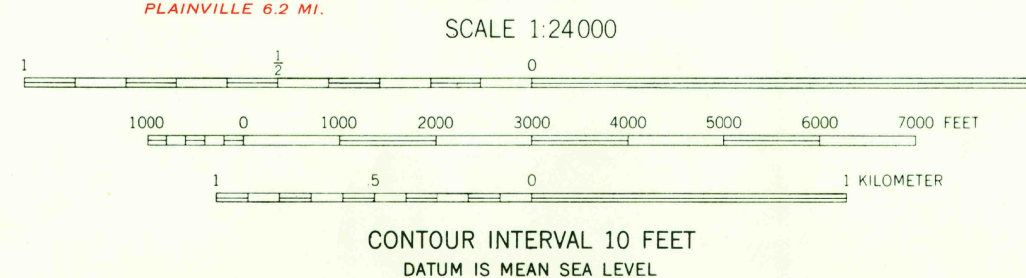
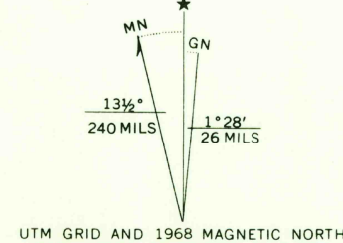

landmark buildings are shown

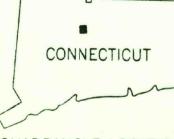
